## ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1550 ESTABLISHING A REQUIREMENT FOR SIDEWALK CONSTRUCION/REPAIR PERMIT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO

That Ordinance number 1550 which reads as follows:

SECTION 1: All persons who repair, or replace sidewalks in the public right-of-way within the Village of Pemberville shall first obtain a sidewalk construction permit from the Village Fiscal Officer. Upon receipt of the permit fee, as established from time-to-time by the Village Council, the Fiscal Officer shall issue a permit and advise the applicant as to the rules and specifications necessary to comply with Village sidewalk construction/repair standards.

Any person repairing or replacing sidewalks located within the public right-of-way without a permit shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor. Each day of said violation shall be considered a separate offense.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

is hereby amended and adopted as follows:

SECTION 1: All persons who repair or replace sidewalks in the public right-of-way with the Village of Pemberville shall first obtain a sidewalk construction permit from the Village office. Upon receipt of the application for the sidewalk construction permit, the office shall advise the applicant of the rules and specifications necessary to comply with the village sidewalk construction/repair standards, including a review of the site and plans for repair/construction by the Zoning Inspector and/or a current employee of the Streets Department prior to the start of any work.

Any person repairing or replacing sidewalks within the public right-of-way without a permit shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor. Each day of said violation shall be considered a separate offense.
