

Streets, Lands & Buildings (SL&B) – May 9, 2023

- 1) Oberhouse Park – Letters were mailed 2/22 & 3/28. Bob Kuhlman is sending the 3rd, Mayor to follow on the status
- 2) Welcome to Pemberville Signs/Spot Lots – No update
- 3) Parks & Recreation:
 - (a) Splash Pad – Plans to complete when the weather breaks
 - (b) Back Boards for basketball court need hung
 - (c) Pool – Concession stand floor to be painted before work date in May
 - (d) Play Ground Mulch at Memorial Park needs mulch.
 - (e) Memorial Park Restrooms – Pool staff to lock and unlock the bathrooms during pool hours. This will be done on a trial basis.
- 4) Town Hall:
 - (a) Painting of Council Chambers – Jeff & Matt to coordinate with Bob Schacht for guidance. This is to be worked on rainy days.
 - (b) Jeff & Matt to edge townhall. A resident is going to pull out the bushes growing over the sidewalks.
- 5) Fair Board – Mayor & Rahe to attend Fair board meeting to discuss usage of the Shelter House (why they remove the doors), bleachers stored at Municipal Building, plans for items stored in grey building at Memorial park, and maintenance of Village property after the fair.
- 6) Flag Stone sidewalks – Looking at options for removal.
- 7) Rees Road Mowing – Mayor provided a map of how the mowing needs to be done around the trees at Memorial Park.
- 8) Flower Pots – Peddle Pushers has requested \$573.00 for flowers for the downtown pots. Flowers are being purchased at Wolf's.
- 9) Memorial Bench's – Jeff & Matt to move the bench in front of the Fork's building.
- 10) Mosquito Sprays – Spraying to start Tuesday May 23rd, and will be done weekly until September.
- 11) Street Sweeps – Jeff received quotes from Dublin (vender who has swept for years) and Progressive. Dublin the same price per sweep as last year, Progressive is \$1200 higher.
