- 1) Oberhouse Park – 3rd letter was sent to the Oberhouse family attorney by Bob Kuhlman. Mayor to check if there is any new information.
- 2) Welcome to Pemberville Signs/Spot Lots – Committee picked out lights and Rahe ordered them from Amazon.
- 3) Town Hall – Painting of Council Chambers: No update - Jeff & Matt to coordinate with Bob Schacht for guidance.
- 4) Street Signs - Replace Memorial Drive & College, Bierly & Front, Hickory & Perry, and all other signs that are faded. A request to put up a “Blind person lives here” sign has been asked to be placed on Water Street, just past the bridge.
- 5) Sidewalk Replacement – Jeff to obtain quotes to replace the sidewalk at 210 Vine Street where a Village tree was removed. Mayor to tell the resident it is his responsibility to coordinate the work.
- 6) ORC Code 731.51-properties with litter – Mayor to send letter to residents at 123 Bierly Ave. Other properties were discussed that maybe in violation of the code.
- 7) 1 Ton Truck – Mayor was contacted by a dealer in Sandusky who has sever ¾ Ton trucks on the lot. Mayor will inquire with Jeff & Matt to see if we could replace the 1 ton with a ¾ ton.
- 8) 341 Front Street – Mayor will tell Jeff & Matt to clean up the tree droppings on the street.
- 9) Verizon Tower – Mayor has been in contact with Diamond Communications regarding the growth of weeds inside the fence of the tower.
- 10) Digital signs – Resident requests have been made to move the sign on Rees Road & on W. Front Street.
- 11) Parks & Recreation:
 - (a) Back Boards for basketball – Jeff & Landry working on getting them down and the new boards installed
 - (b) Memorial Park Restrooms – Jeff & Matt to unlock in the mornings, pool staff to lock at night.
 - (c) Memorial Park Restrooms – Reviewed quote to replace the doors. Need to look at other options.
 - (d) Ball Park Bleachers – Still looking for a new home for the bleachers at the ball diamonds. If no one wants them, we will tear down so we can place the FairBoards bleachers at the park after the fair.
 - (e) Pool Flag Pole Area – Marcia indicated Mike & Vicky Samson will take care of area.
 - (f) Sewer grate – Mayor to work with Nathan on securing the sewer grate in from of the pool.
