

Streets, Lands & Buildings (SL&B) – October 10, 2024

- 1) Cedar Street “No Semi Sign” – Signs placed by ODOT have caused confusion (semi’s are thinking they can’t travel 105). The committee suggests trying to remove the signs and place a “No Semi” sign on Cedar Street.
- 2) Leaf pickup – Leaf machine is running and ready to go.
- 3) Sign Replacements – Numerous need replaced.
- 4) Oberhouse Park – The Mayor received a complaint form regarding the high grass since the “Private Property” signs have been placed. The Oberhouse’s will not allow the neighbor to who has maintained the property for years to continue, even if he signs a waiver. The Mayor to send the Oberhouse’s a letter of violation.
- 5) Mason Park – Bob Bruning suggested placing solar lights on the walk way. Will look for some that you can mow over.
- 6) Town Hall lobby – Winter project to paint the lobby
- 7) Kesson Road – Mayor & Susie met with the Township Trustees. The Trustees are going to ask the county engineer to provide options and cost estimates for repair
- 8) Pool
 - (1) Brown Stone provided a quote of \$1500 to epoxy the shower floors.
- 9) Memorial Park
 - (1) Grey Building – Painting of the grey building will not get done this year.
 - (2) Restrooms – Paint inside bathroom dividers
- 10) Pember Grove
 - (1) The streets appear to be holding water causing severe cracking in numerous locations. We’re working with Steve Darmafoul to see if we can determine the cause.
 - (2) Parking This Side of Street signs – May need to be installed in the future.
