- 1) Leaf pickup – Ended the week of 12/9. Jeff & Matt to continue cleaning the curbs and catch basins.
- 2) Downtown sidewalks & snow removal – Mayor voiced her concern about the extras (tables & chairs/sandwich boards) on the sidewalks & snow removal. Options were discussed on how to possibly address.
- 3) EPA Grant – Mayor may apply for an EPA grant for a new leaf machine
- 4) Salt – We have plenty of salt to get started. Weather to determine if additional will be needed.
- 5) 2025 Mowers – Rahe to check with Sarah on quotes for leasing.
- 6) Street behind businesses – Will obtain quotes for fixing road behind businesses.
- 7) Summer Help – Plan to budget part time help for mowing
- 8) Town Hall lobby – Paint by end of January
- 9) 104 Bierley – Reviewed complaint received regarding the former Oberhouse Park. The homeowner is not happy with how the property is being maintained.
- 10) Kesson Road – The Trustees are going to ask the county engineer to provide options and cost estimates for repair – No updates
- 11) Memorial Park
 - (1) Grey Building – Painting of the grey building – 2025 project
 - (2) Restrooms – Paint inside bathroom dividers – Winter Project
 - (3) Pickle Ball Court – Fair Board to buy paint for repairs to the court – Spring 2025 project
 - (4) Splash Pad – Tree hanging over the pad needs trimmed – Will look at now that leaf pick up is over.
 - (5) Basket Ball Court – Cement to be replaced in 2025. Contractor will require assistance
- 12) Pember Grove – No update
 - (1) The streets appear to be holding water causing severe cracking in numerous locations – Still evaluating
 - (2) No Parking This Side of Street signs – May need to be installed in the future.
