Issue:

- 1. **Grant for village alarm**: FEMA informed the Mayor that there will not be grant money available to replace the aging tornado alarm currently stationed at the top of the current water tower. This is due to the low priority and limited funds for such a project. If by some chance, the grant was approved, it will take two years to go through the process. The Mayor plans to go to the Township and ask them to increase their assistance in replacing the alarm. The cost will be \$33,500 in total. Funds for this project would come from the permanent improvements.
- 2. **Salary packages**: The Mayor put together all of the current salary packages for the law-enforcement department. That information will be made readily available to all Council members.
- 3. **Charge for use of shooting range**: former Pemberville Officer Moore has requested the use of the village shooting range to assist in qualifying security officers. Chief John Vaughn will look into an appropriate amount to charge and present to the Council for their consideration to allow an outside organization to use the shooting range.
