VILLAGE OF PEMBERVILLE BOARD OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS SPECIAL MEETING March 12, 2025

Present at the special meeting of the Board of Public Affairs were President Kim Long, Dean Krukemyer, Clerk Melody Siebenaler, Mayor Bailey, Nathan Schultze, Landry Sheets, Hirzel Canning representatives-Karl Hirzel, Joseph Hirzel II and Kleinfelder Engineering representatives-Steve Wonderly, Nate Hudeck, and Paul Fletcher.

Discussion ensued regarding installation of a well in Kahler Road woods and possible additional sewer discharge from Hirzel Canning plant. Landry discussed concerns with BOD's and the amount of discharge will overflow the Bierly pump station. Karl mentioned using tanks behind old Modine building to store and discharge during low flow times. Hirzel Canning has a 50 day / 6 day a week processing season. Landry will discuss situation with Scott Briggs (Control Associates) and see if we have suggestions for metering the discharge until go into low flow situation. Mayor Bailey mentioned that Joe Jr. had conversation with Nathan stating Hirzel Canning would help fund installing a new well in Kahler Woods. Well #7 would be demolished increasing the area for land used for applying Hirzel by product. Landry would like to wait until he gets NDPS to determine what numbers he will be required to be held to. Karl mentioned Village may need to change Ordinance to reflect current requirements and conditions. All agreed to continue discussions and move toward acceptable outcome for all involved.
