- 1) Logging Kahler Woods – Mayor reported winter project
- 2) Walnut Street Garage – Council had already voted to proceed with the sale, Following the last council meeting, the Mayor felt some actions could be interpreted as circumventing the decision.
- 3) Frontier Bldg behind bank – Used to be owned by GTE, Mayor working on renegotiating a new contract with Frontier who now occupies the space
- 4) 411 Oak Street – Residents have greenhouses in the right of way of the alley. They have been notified to remove them.
- 5) Downtown Alley The alley stretching from Pine to Cedar Streets – Fenson has been awarded the contract to replace the waterlines for the entire length of the alley. Mayor asks that the Village replace that length of asphalt.
- 6) 118 E Front Street – Owner has requested to remove the arborvitae's located behind his business in coordination with the village since the trees are on both properties.
- 7) Memorial Park
 - (1) Gaga Court – waterproof/seal in the fall – To be done weather permitting
 - (2) Locks – New locks are difficult. Chief Vaughn was able to get them lock
