

Special streets meeting for August 10,2026

The committee went into executive session to discuss the sale of property

We asked Steve to attend this meeting to discuss other possibilities of Mapping out the waterlines and giving a simple update of the plan that we already have for the streets. He said that could work Steve will talk to the BPA further about the waterline repair project for 2027.

A traffic count will take place the week of August 17 on the following streets, Bierley, Pine and Oak Streets.

Discussion of continuing the main water loop from the north plant to the south water plant and searching out Grant money for the projects for both the water and the street repair (College to Bierley Ave).

Steve did mention it's too late for 2027 Grant money as of now, but we will focus on a plan for 2027/2028 going forward.

Master plans were discussed; communication with Steven and Nate resulted in discussing water breaks, Where our Waterlines are located and how to move forward repairing streets and water lines.

Steve suggested an asset management plan versus a five-year plan. The study would update the water map, areas of fire protection (water pressure) and help us determine where to start future projects so we can best utilize funds and give recommendations to council.

Steve also discussed a 0% loan for life of the loan through Ohio public works and the amount needed, drainage and elevation and the details needed for that loan. He also said it is possible to pay 50% of the project have 25% covered by loan and 25% of it covered by grants. These are all being considered now by Steve And will be reviewed by the committee accordingly.
