## The New Leisure United Blakelaw officially opened on 6 February


A state-of-the-art football and gym facilities opened this month to Newcastle communities.

Previous grass pitches prone to water logging at Blakelaw Park has been replaced and transformed with all-weather 3G surfaces and new community buildings which comprise of group changing facilities, club rooms, community café and state-of-the-art gym.

The project was made possible thanks to investment from the Premier League, The FA and Government's Football Foundation and Newcastle City Council. The hub is funded as part of a citywide approach to improve facilities to help increase football participation in safe and fully managed facilities accessible by the whole community. Charitable Trust, Leisure United are the appointed operator for the new community hubs.

Gym members can access to vary their workouts from as little as £24.50 per month for a gym and classes dual access membership. Contract, non-contract, annual and concessionary memberships are available too from just £19.50 per month.

Football activities will include pay and play football, football development sessions for children, school holiday camps, wildcats (girls' sessions), walking football, leagues and tournaments. The pitches and coaching rooms can also be hired for corporate events, meetings and private parties.
