Good News Additional funding to tackle anti-social behaviour

Back in June the Community Council made an application for funding to the Police and Crime Commissioner's Operation Payback fund to assist us to tackle anti-social behaviour in the area.

We are delighted to share that our application was successful, and we have been granted over £4000 to assist us with this work. We will share our plans for this funding over the coming months so please keep an eye out for regular updates.

Kim McGuinness- Police and Crime Commissioner for Northumbria said:

'The fund was extremely competitive, and I am pleased to be able to award you this money.

Yours was one of several 'stand-out' projects that I believe can really help to address anti-social behaviour and repair the harm it causes in Northumberland, Tyne and Wear, as well as contributing to helping me deliver my policing and crime priorities.'

Operation Payback is a fund designed to ensure neighbourhoods benefit from police action targeting criminals and is underpinned by money seized from criminals. In the years to come the fund will be topped up with some of the money seized from criminal activity under the Proceeds of Crime Act.

The Community Council are working tirelessly to tackle the ongoing issues we have with Anti-social behaviour in the area.

Universal Credit is replacing 6 other benefits

Many people are still on those 'legacy benefits' and are uncertain whether they have to claim UC and whether they would be better or worse off under UC. We are told that in the next year or two – the DWP will write to those who are still on the legacy benefits - telling them they have to claim UC and their legacy benefits will stop.

BUT in the meantime, we want to encourage you to find out now, if you

would be better or worse off on Universal Credit. What are the pros and cons of claiming UC? This is even more important in the current cost of living crisis

More communications will be sent in late September, early October to residents telling them to find out and to get advice and support via the Newcastle city council webpage.

Heart of Blakelaw Project


On the 2nd of August the community of Blakelaw came together for an outdoor art exhibition.
