What We Did

We set out early ambitions which respond to the social, economic, and environmental challenges Newcastle is facing and asked a series of questions as part of the consultation to test these ambitions.

We attended events including coffee mornings, community events, had stalls in the Grainger Market and used an online platform to promote the consultation.

What You Told Us

We received a good response of over 700 comments with themes including:

- Creating healthy places including opportunities to promote walking, cycling, and public transport.
- Addressing the climate crisis, including building energy efficient homes, and focusing employment uses in sustainable locations.
- Supporting our local high streets.
- Promoting Newcastle's history and heritage along with providing new natural spaces, and ensuring existing spaces are safe and attractive.
- There should be more housing to meet the specific needs of disabled people and a wider range of types of property including affordable housing.

- The need to improve biodiversity and protect wildlife.
