Playing field wildflower meadow & hedge

Members of FoRGE will scarify the meadow area and sow yellow rattle and some extra wildflower seeds during November. It's hoped that this will help to reduce the excess grass for next year's flowers.

The hedge will be trimmed back a little in the winter to keep the plants strong and healthy.

Maintenance of hedges in The Valley & Valley Road

WCC trimmed back the verges in the Valley and Valley Road on 18th October.

I have reported the overgrown hedge leading down to the Valley on Lewis Road.
