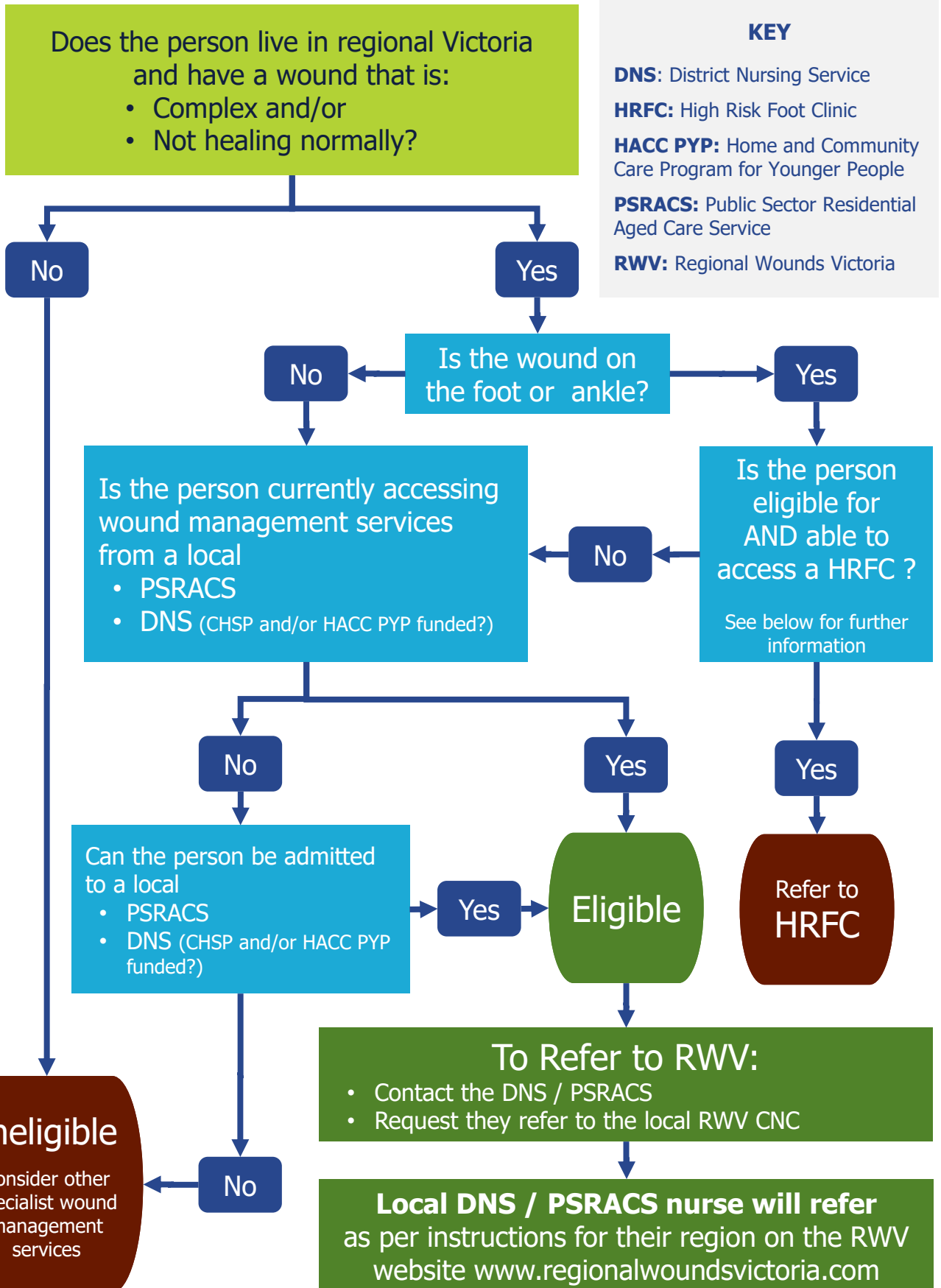

High Risk Foot Clinics in Regional Victoria

High Risk Foot Services in regional Victoria, which have

- Capacity to manage the most complex, high risk foot
- 24 hour access to an operational Emergency Department
- Minimum of one medical specialist on the inter disciplinary team

Please note: Other services may exist that can manage the high risk foot of lower complexity

Grampians	Ballarat Sub region Ballarat Health High Risk Foot Clinic	People with complex high risk foot issues and complications, including: foot ulcerations which are not progressing, history of amputation and current foot wound, suspected Charcot neuroarthropathy, complex foot pain.
Hume	East Sub region Gateway Heath High Risk Foot clinic Wangaratta West Sub region Goulburn Valley High Risk Foot Clinic	People with active foot pathologies that place them at risk of hospitalisation and require multidisciplinary assessment, such as active foot ulceration, recent amputation, infection and suspected Charcot's neuroarthropathy. Loddon Mallee	Bendigo Health High Risk Foot Clinic	People with foot pathologies placing them at a high risk of amputation (eg; Foot ulceration, Infection, Charcot's neuroarthropathy) due to diabetes or other conditions.
