Our donations to the World Centres

You will know from our last AGM that we were able to donate £8,000 to the World Centres.

This was split equally, giving each Centre £1,600 to each World Centre.

- To Nuestra Cabana our money was given to be put towards technology and provide better internet and social media services
- Our Chalet Cleaning Equipment, such as mops/mop heads/buckets and walkie talkies, a tent and 3 pump flasks
- Sangam we gave £1,400 on funding bursaries and the remaining £200 on jam, marmite and smoke detectors
- Pax Lodge a chest freezer to keep ice creams and frozen meals in to sell, a storage cupboard, some sanitary bins and a large freezer for staff to keep their food in
- Kusafiri Our donation was given to Kusafiri asking them to use this towards scholarships at their request.

The donations and our membership mean we can provide extra financial support to the 5 World Centres, enabling them to stay open and provide opportunities to our Girl Guides and Girl Scouts worldwide.

We want to keep the charity running and are looking for ways to increase our membership, raise our profile and promote who we are and what we do, so that we can continue supporting the World Centres.

Please continue your support the group, your membership fee really does count, and we hope to see many of you at the events we are attending during the year.

As we, (Caroline and Karen) step down from our role as joint chair of the group, we want to thank the Trustees who have been with us along the way and for their continuing advice and support.
