Following notification of this member's death, details of the benefits payable are set out below:

### 1. Lump sum death benefit

- The total lump sum death benefit (LSDB) is £487,581.87, comprising:
  - Refund of the deceased member's 'Personal Retirement Account' of £260,580.87 (split between the deceased member's element of £90,579.58, the employer's element of £144,927.33 and the employer's augmentation element of £25,073.96)
  - Life assurance benefit of £227,001.00
- The LSDB is payable to persons at the Trustees' discretion, and so the Trustees should confirm to whom the benefits should be paid and in what proportions
- The LSDB is within the deceased member's available Lump Sum & Death Benefit Allowance (LS&DBA) of £1,049,888.50
