



Purpose: Our goal is to enhance Nevada County's ability to seek and secure grant funding. Specifically, this team will support County departments as well as community partners, to find, vet, apply to, and win grant funding aligned with County and community goals.

Functions/ Responsibilities:

- Identification of funding opportunities (prospecting)
- Alignment and Assessment of funding opportunities (vetting)
- Proposal Development
- Project Readiness
- Advocacy





OPPORTUNITIES

Provide support to improve grants identification ("prospecting") systems. Provide tools
and structure to monitor Federal and State opportunities.

Establish "vetting" process to ensure opportunities reach the right "champion(s)" in a timely manner.

Provide a <u>structure to support collaboration and coordination</u> of projects.

Develop <u>capacity to write proposals</u>.



MORE OPPORTUNITIES!

- <u>Develop "shovel ready" project/program proposals.</u> Develop Agency and partner wish lists/project pipelines. Establish mechanisms to share plans/wishes/projects among leaders so they can identify collaborations and share funding sources.
- Support <u>administrative and implementation capacity.</u> Some services may be provided by contracted grant writers/consultants; <u>enhancing partner capacity</u>; explore possibilities to identify match funding when appropriate.
- Identify and coordinate advocacy opportunities. Proactively identify collective advocacy priorities to advance with CSAC, NACo, state and federal lobbyists, etc. Support nexus between fund development, planning, and advocacy.
- **Staff focused on identification**, sharing, coordination, development

Grants Coordinator Role:

- **Prospecting**: Understanding of county-wide projects and needs, playing match-maker to a) grant opportunities, b) other complementary projects
- **Vetting**: Checking all the boxes. Matching requirements? Timeline?
- Convening: Communicating with county departments, local partners, grantors, etc.



Prospecting

- What are your strategic goals?
- Where is the project at? Is your project defined? Is it shovel-ready?
- Are you or your partners eligible? 501c3? Tribal government? Local government?

So you're interested...

- Will this project be feasible?
- What is the given timeline (maybe you postpone for next year and work towards the goal of being ready at a later date)?
- Do you have the staff capacity?
- Do you have the infrastructure?



Convening

- Who is taking the lead?
- What are the deadlines?
- What is your roadmap?
- Do you have to designate assignments?
- Will you need documents, maps, data you don't have?

- Figure this out first! No one likes confusion about responsibility.
- Mark your calendars, set up reminders.
- Identify everyone's strengths and access to resources and assign accordingly.
- Give time to organize important documents and data. Numbers speak loudly.












Shaded Fuel Break Projects, Western Nevada County
