Course Description:

START on the A10 (Downham Market - King's Lynn) in lay-by 200 yards north of church at South Runcton.

Proceed southwards along A10 to Bexwell roundabout (Junction of A10/A1122) (3.7 miles). Take first exit onto A1122, and continue to Stradsett where turn left onto A134 (6.3 miles). Proceed along A134 to

FINISH 60 yards beyond signpost for Church Lane, Tottenhill. (10.017 miles).


