| A joyous, swashbuckling masterpiece starring Errol Flynn in his athletic prime, with Olivia de Havilland Maid Marian, Basil Rathbone as the dastardly Sir Guy of Gisbourne, Claude Rains as the usurping King John, and directed by Michael Curtiz, music by Erich Korngold.
