#### ST FAITHS PARISH CHURCH OF ST MARY AND ST ANDREW The Church of England and the Methodist Church Worshipping & Working Together

Once again the year is flying by and we are already turning our thoughts to autumn. In our churches that means we are preparing to celebrate Harvest Festival together. It is still a very popular feast in the Church calendar, reminding us of God's generous and bountiful gifts.

The custom of Harvest Festivals goes right back to the Jewish tradition, when people were required to bring the first fruits of their labours to the priest as a thanks offering to God for another year's harvest.

As we continue this tradition in a more modern way, we fill our churches with wheatsheaves, fruit, flowers, vegetables and so on, as well as tinned and packet foods, to celebrate this year's harvest that has been safely gathered in. At one Harvest Festival I conducted a few years ago, the church was crowded with both children and parents, and the children were asked to suggest the names of various foods beginning with all the letters of the alphabet. The children were really quick off the mark: A for apple, B for bread, C for cauliflower and so on. But when they got to the letter Q, the silence was deafening. Suddenly, one little girl shot her hand up in the air, and, to the delight of the congregation and utter embarrassment of her mother, she proudly proclaimed: 'Q is for cucumber!'

So often we take our food for granted. We turn up at the supermarket and take things off the shelves and purchase all manner of things to fill our fridges, our freezers, and our cupboards without giving a thought as to where it comes from or how it got to us. Perhaps it is only when we cannot afford to buy the food we need, or perhaps when there is no food because of drought or flood and so on, that we really begin to think about it.

These days, the produce collected at our harvest festivals is donated to foodbanks or local refuge centres, so that those who don't have enough can be fed and fed well.

The most important aspect of a harvest festival is to give thanks to God who provides us with the soil, the rain, the seed and the sunshine, which all combine and work together to bring food to our tables. It is important, too, to thank, and pray for, our farmers and everyone who works in our food industries to produce such wonderful food.

I don't know about you, but I was always brought up to say Grace, a prayer of thanks, before a meal – to thank God for the food in front of me. It is a discipline that I continue still today – and have done through school and home, and even college. It reminds me that it is only by the grace of God that I have food to eat. It reminds me of all those who don't have enough and encourages me to help those who are in need. If you don't already do that, why not give it a go.

Better still, why not go along to a church Harvest Festival near you over the next few weeks. Ours is on Sunday 29th September at St Faiths' Church. We all have something to be thankful for, so let's join together in thanking God for all his good gifts and help those who most need it at the same time. You might just be surprised how much things have changed since you were small.

The additional play equipment has been installed at the park on Coltishall Lane which includes a new set of swings, a wheelchair access roundabout, a multiplay area and skateboard facilities. New gates for the entrance on Coltishall Lane are on order and these will include a self-closing pedestrian gate. Initial response to this new facility has been very favourable and it is being well used.

The Council still has access to some funding as a result of the development off Manor Road and they continue to evaluate future projects.

Street cleaning by Broadland DC is no longer on a fixed schedule. The latest contract means that streets are inspected regularly and then swept on a perceived priority rather than sweeping something where there is no need.

Overhanging hedges become an increasing problem at this time of year, particularly after such wet weather and residents are asked to give consideration to neighbours and passing pedestrians and to keep their hedges cut back.

Three vacancies remain on the Council which has powers to co-opt. Any resident who may wish to be considered should contact the Clerk for an informal discussion on what is involved.

#### **ORCHIDS**

Orchids are beautiful flowers that are great for growing indoors. While these little plants are fairly easy to look after, special care must be taken when pruning orchids. Follow these steps to properly prune off old wood to make room for new blooms.

#### How to Prune an Orchid

Use the orchid pruning tips below to keep your orchids looking good and healthy.

Make sure you have super sharp pruning shears to use on your orchid. The sharper the shears, the cleaner the cut will be. A clean cut makes for a healthier orchid.

While the orchid is still blooming, cut back the flowers that are fading. Removing the orchid blooms that have finished will not only keep your plant looking neat but will increase its vitality.

Make a clean, even cut directly back to the main branch. Keep this up while the plant is blooming.

When the orchid is completely done blooming and all the flowers have faded, you can do the major pruning. Most orchids will go dormant in the fall, so plan on doing your pruning then.

Trim the stem that had the blooms on it off about an inch (2.5 cm.) away from the main stalk. Make the cut clean and even. If there are any places on the stalk that have turned yellow or brown, cut them back completely so that the plant will grow back healthier.

Remove the orchid from its pot. Prune away any dead or damaged roots. Replant the orchid in a bigger pot each year so that it has more room to grow.

#### **Young Orchids**

If your orchid is fairly young, you want to encourage it to grow bigger roots and blooms. The best way to cut orchid plants when they are young is to trim the stalk all the way back to 1 inch (2.5 cm.) from the base of the plant. As it grows back, it will have stronger roots, bigger leaves, and larger blooms.



#### A Year in Review

Just as we could see the summer holidays on the horizon, here at St Faiths', we received a phone call from... Ofsted! The last Wednesday before we broke up, 2 inspectors spent the day with us. Although we had lots planned for the final week, we welcomed the opportunity to show off our fantastic school.

We will have to wait for the next academic year for Ofsted's report, and therefore will share this in due course.

#### Wraparound Care

A new Wraparound Pathfinder Scheme was announced in the Spring 2023 Budget by the previous Government. The ambition of this scheme is that all primary-aged children can access 8.00am to 6.00pm childcare provision, term time only.

This scheme has enabled us to access a grant to put some wraparound provision in place from September 2024. We will be able to offer Breakfast Provision at St Faiths' each morning from 8.00am. The After School Provision will be shared between the 3 Harnser schools (Frettenham, Hainford and St Faiths' Primary Schools) but based at St. Faiths', with all children being collected by 6.00pm.

The Provision both before and after school will be staffed by our school and Federation staff. It will provide a friendly environment where children of all ages can relax before and after school or choose to take part in a range of age-appropriate activities, including accessing some of the outdoor areas or completing homework if the children wish to.
