A dad was driving his little boy down a country road on a beautiful spring afternoon. Suddenly, out of nowhere, a bumble bee flew in through the open car window. The little boy was fatally allergic to bee stings, so, quite understandably he was petrified. But his dad reacted very quickly. He reached out in an instant, and grabbed hold of the bee. He squeezed it in his hand, and then released it. But as soon as he let it go, the little boy started panicking again, especially when it flew close to him. The dad stopped the car, and once again, reached out his hand. This time, he pointed to his hand. There, sticking out of his skin was the bee's sting. "Do you see this?" he asked his son. "You don't need to be afraid anymore. I have taken the sting for you."

And, putting it simply, that's the message of Easter. We no longer have anything to fear, as Jesus has died on our behalf. He has conquered death and evil, and has saved us from our sin.

On Holy Saturday, the day before Easter Day, Jesus' friends would have been reeling from the horrific events of Good Friday; that awful day, when the man they had loved and followed and worked alongside for the past three years – and who they thought would lead them into new and exciting things – that day Jesus had been brutally murdered; nailed to a cross like any common criminal, even though he had done nothing wrong. He was dead.

How were they supposed to feel? What were they supposed to do next? They were confused, shocked, and bewildered. How could they have got it so wrong?

Except they hadn't got it wrong at all.

The simplest meaning of Easter is that we are living in a world in which God has the final word. On Good Friday it appears that the devil is indeed the king of the world. The most holy and most lovable man in the history of the world was dead. A cross, a handful of nails, a jeering mob and a quick thrust of a spear had ended all the hopes of the world. Those hours when his voice was silent, were the blackest hours the human race has ever known. If the authorities could put an end to Jesus, then no one could ever hope again.

Thankfully, we know that that wasn't to be the end of the story. Jesus kept his promise and on Easter Day, as we now know it, Jesus rose from the grave. Alive! Triumphant!

Jesus took the sting on our behalf. He came back from the dead to bring us to a new life with him, now and for all of eternity. And the really Good News is that the new life he offers is for everyone – whoever we are, wherever we are, and whatever we've done. All we have to do is ask. Why not join in the celebration? Come along to your local church, hear the story and find out what it's all about for yourself. You never know, it might just change your whole life.

But whatever you do, have a joyful and happy Easter.

The Council have made a grant of £3,000 to the newly formed St.Faiths Community Volunteer Group to purchase equipment for use throughout the parish.

Verge cutting within the built up area of the parish will continue to be carried out by the Council's own contractor following agreement with Norfolk County Council on the level of a grant to carry out this work.

The vacant allotments have been re-let and any resident wishing to be added to the short waiting list should contact the Clerk.

BT have changed their mind about disconnecting the telephone kiosk on Norwich Road following an objection from Broadland District Council on the grounds of poor mobile signals in the area.

At the February meeting the Council co-opted Stephen Lawrence as a member of the Council

The Council have been successful in their bid to Norfolk County Council for 50/50 funding for a SAM2 speed monitoring sign. Once sites have been agreed with NCC (it has to be moved every four weeks) the sign will be ordered and should be in place in the summer.

This season seems to have flown past for me, but it has been good to be able to partake and do reasonably well after a season off last year.

Our Norwich Division 1 team SFC A may not quite make the silverware, but can be proud to lie in 4th place with just a couple of matches left to play. Top of the averages with 75% success figures is Club captain/secretary, Ben Briggs, so a very satisfactory season for him so far.

An even more successful season so far for SFC B in Division 2. For Those players, who lie comfortably in second place, it could result in promotion if their last two matches go to plan. Their 3 regular players Danny Atkins, Andrew Latham, and Teucer Wilson, have recorded 70% singles success figures, which is impressive. Between them, they have been voted "player of the match" a total of 9 times over the season, as recorded on the Table Tennis England website, where all our match results can be viewed.

In Norwich Division 3, 5th position for the team I play for, is OK, with mid table placing assured. We have not had a particularly settled team, as 9 different players have been called in when regulars have been unavailable.
