Leighton Corinthians in one of the oldest Youth Football Clubs in the town, and we are currently going through a great period of growth that is helping us provide opportunities for youth football to an increasing number of children across Leighton Buzzard.

During the seasons that were impacted by Covid controls and Lockdowns, we saw a decline in the teams and members associated with the club, but since last year we have worked hard as a committee at reversing this trend and have been able to Add Teams at U7, U8, U9 and U10 last year, and this year we have further increased our memberships with a new U7 team and an additional U8 Team, so added to the existing boys and girls teams that we had we now have 10 teams across the club, and have around 150 playing members that we provide training and matches with on a weekly basis.

Whilst this growth is fantastic for the club, it also presents financing challenges, but we have been lucky to secure the support of many local businesses and have been able to secure Sponsorship for all ten teams this year, enabling us to kit all the teams out in new match day kits for the season (which bear the names and logo's of our sponsors), as well as training kit that is then used as an away kit should colours clash.

In addition to the Sponsors (Detailed below), we would also like to express our thanks to our committee that help us run the club, our partners at the Stanbridge and Tilsforth Community Hall that host us every Saturday morning for Matchdays, and Van Dyke School where we are founding users of the new Surface at the school for training on a Tuesday 18.00-19.00 and our twenty+ managers and coaches that help make all of this possible.
