One of the events we did attend in June was a "Volunteers Fair" in All Saints Leighton Buzzard and we got a number of leads for the committee, but also made some good contacts with the local council, As a result have secured £1000 Grant and £500 matched funding for the club. This has enabled us to buy a new set of Full Size goals for our U15 and U16 Girls Teams as we now have 4 teams on full size pitches, as well as a further 5 teams hosted on the other two pitches at Tilsworth. With the continued growth of the club, we are now partnering with Beaudesert School on Saturday mornings, and our U7 and U8 teams will play out of there for their 1<sup>st</sup> two seasons, with the Debut game scheduled for our U7's this weekend.

## **Early Season Updates**

Equipment & Kit has been a challenge over the summer, impacted by a fire at one of our major suppliers meaning that they stopped taking orders just as we needed to place our order. We also then had a late flurry of new players since the end of August, which has been a great benefit to some of our teams with lower numbers, but does create difficulty when ordering kit. We are now almost on top of this, helped by amazing work (and late hours) from our Club Secretary and treasurer to get everyone registered and paid, and I thank everyone for their patience as we close this out.

For new members we had around 30 new players across existing teams, and an especially warm Welcome to Steve Brooks and his new U7 Team. It's a great pleasure to welcome new teams into the club each year, and also important for the long term health of the club, and so it's been great to have Steve join us with great enthusiasm and energy. He has also been successful in getting sponsorship for his Team Kit, and a 2<sup>nd</sup> sponsor for an additional training jacket which is being organised. Whilst other kits are all sponsored, if you know anyone who may be interested in supporting the club with Sponsorship please let me know and I can share details of sponsorship opportunities available. On funds, THANKS for the 50% of club that have paid subs in full, for others September payments are due next week.

Finally a couple of pointers for the next few months.. We are looking to organise our first club social of the year, which will hopefully be a chance for players to socialise off the pitch, and also for parents to get to know each other away from the sidelines, more details to follow. Further we will also then look to schedule a Christmas Party which is always great for the younger side of the club, and then we will also be supporting the Local Rotary Club on the Traditional Santa Walk Then as we enter 2025 which will be our 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary look out for special anniversary events too,
