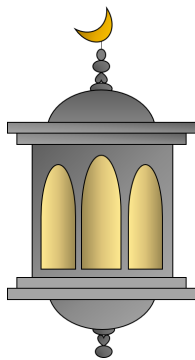
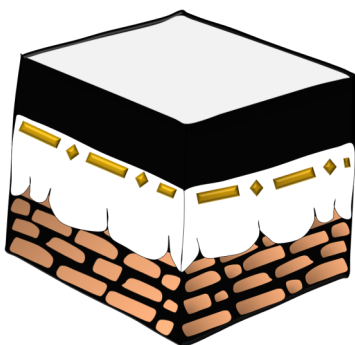
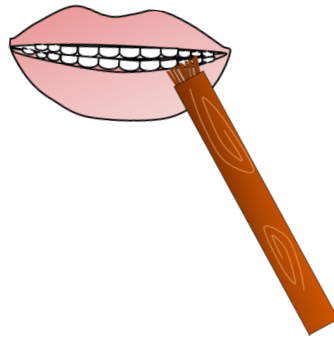


HOW WELL DO YOU KNOW RAMADAN?

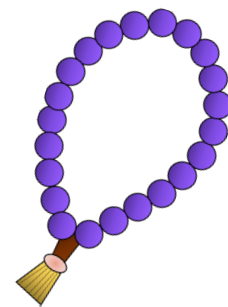
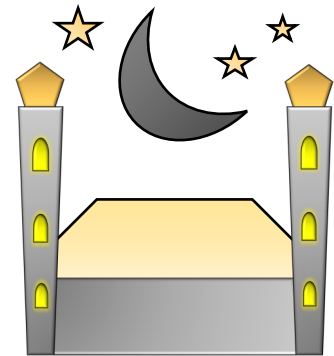
