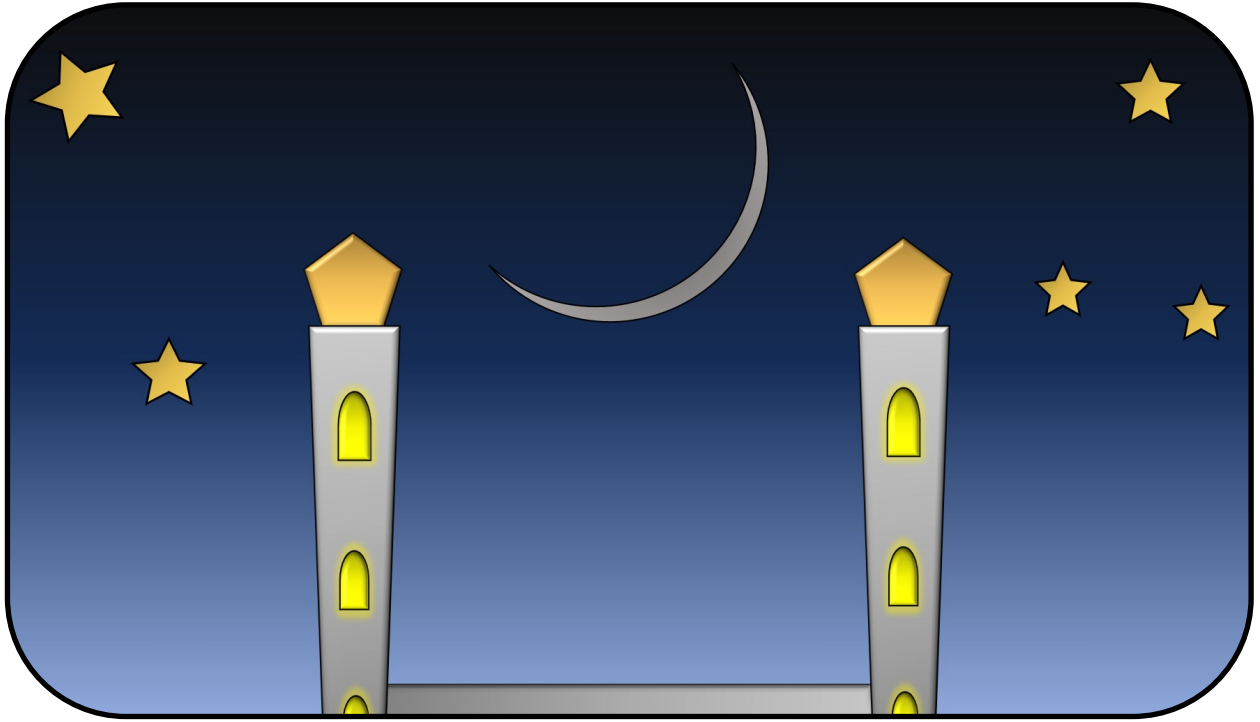

Suhoor takes place before Fajr.

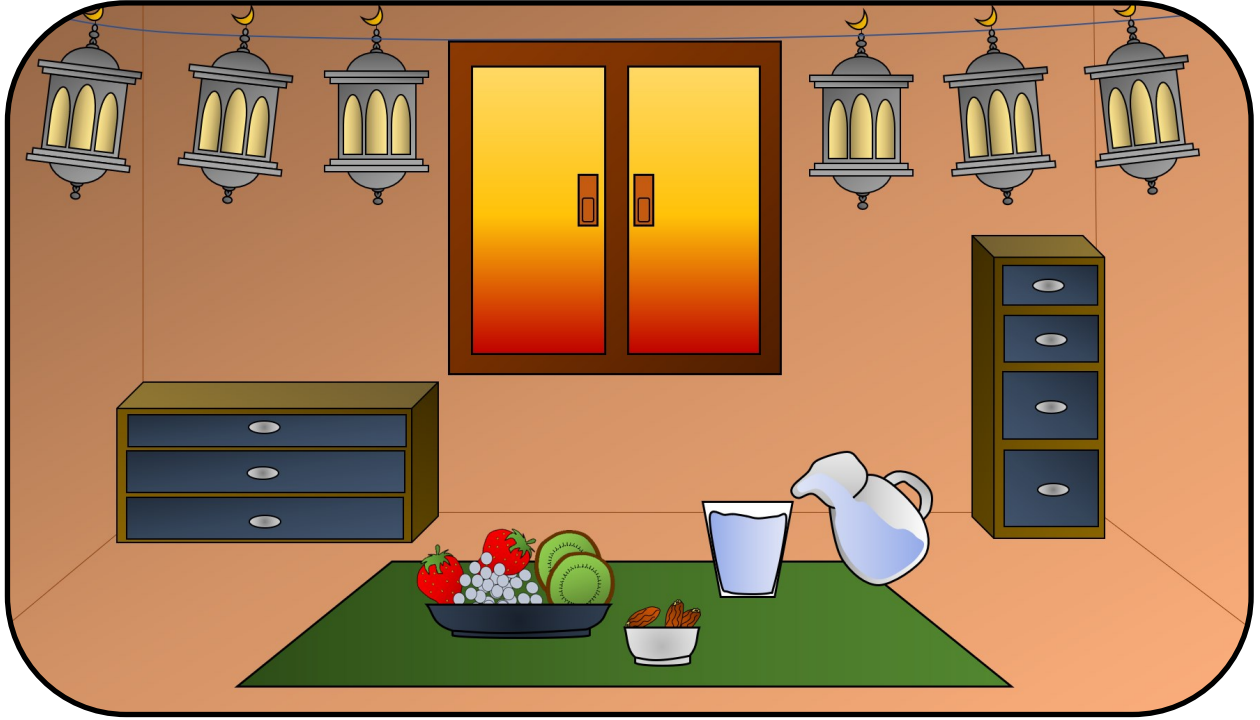
It is Sunnah to partake in

water or a few dates.



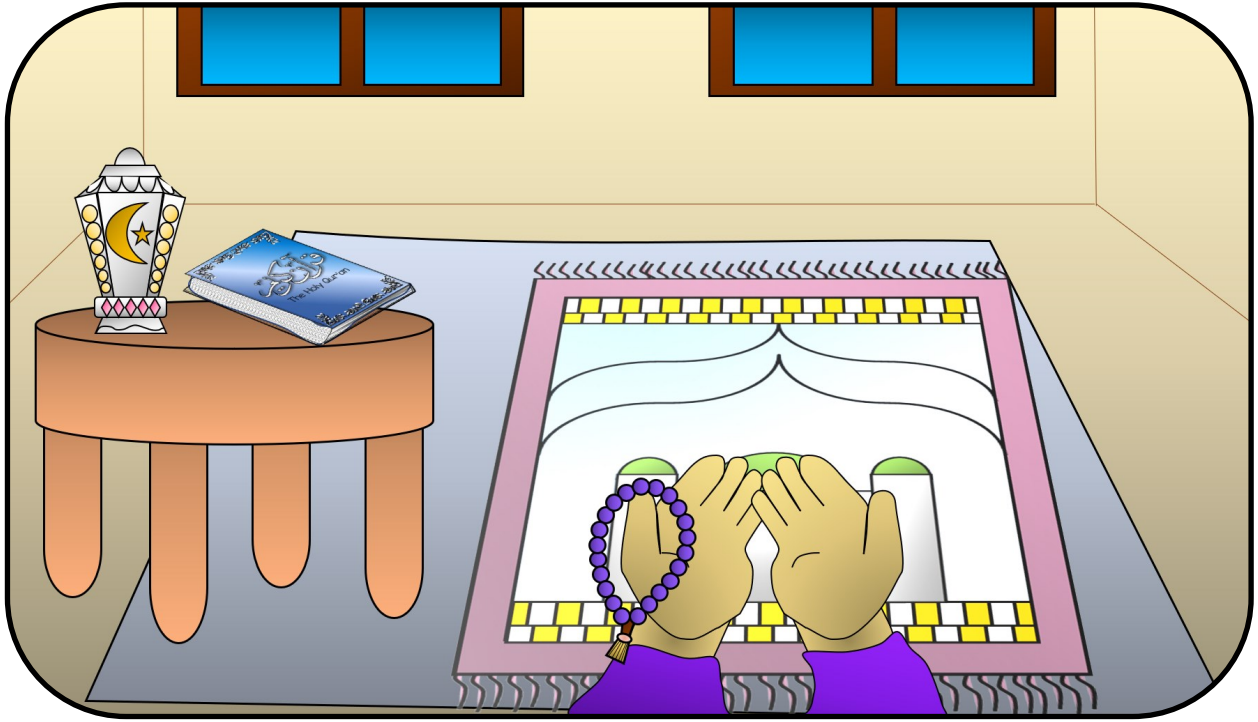
# Ramadan sentence tracing

This meal is called Iftar.

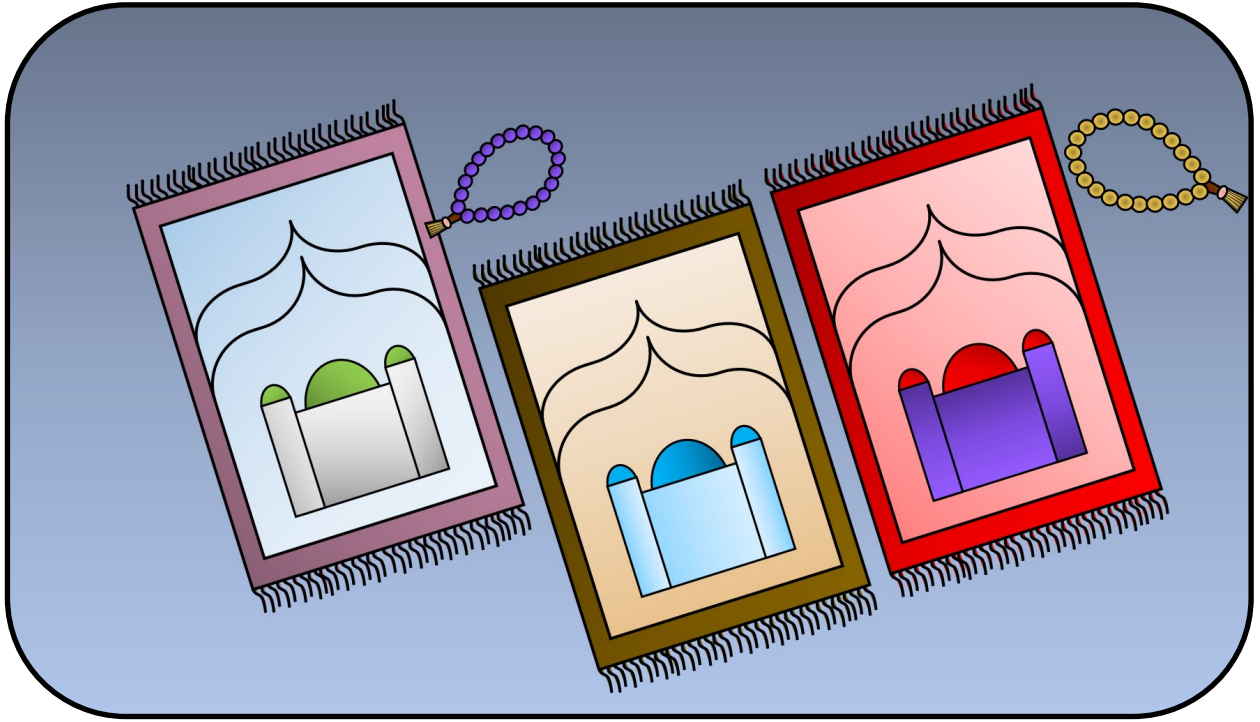
# Ramadan sentence tracing

Qur'an.

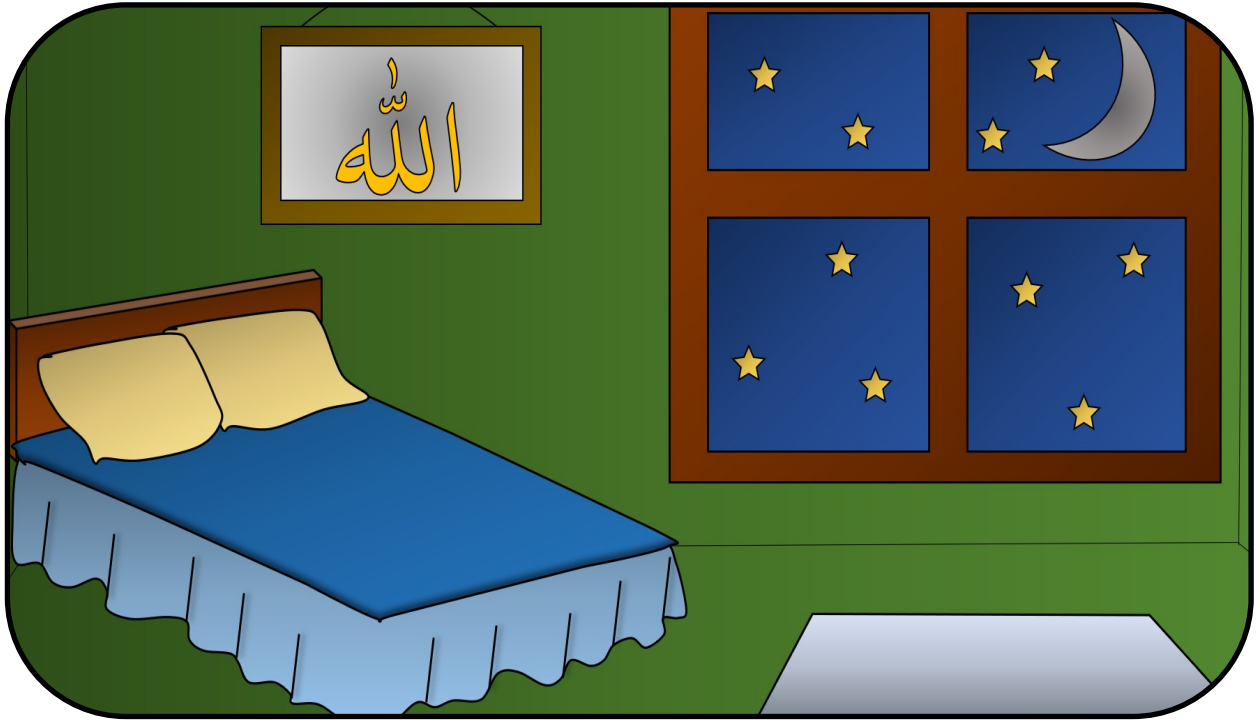
Angel Jibra'eel was sent down

Ramadan.

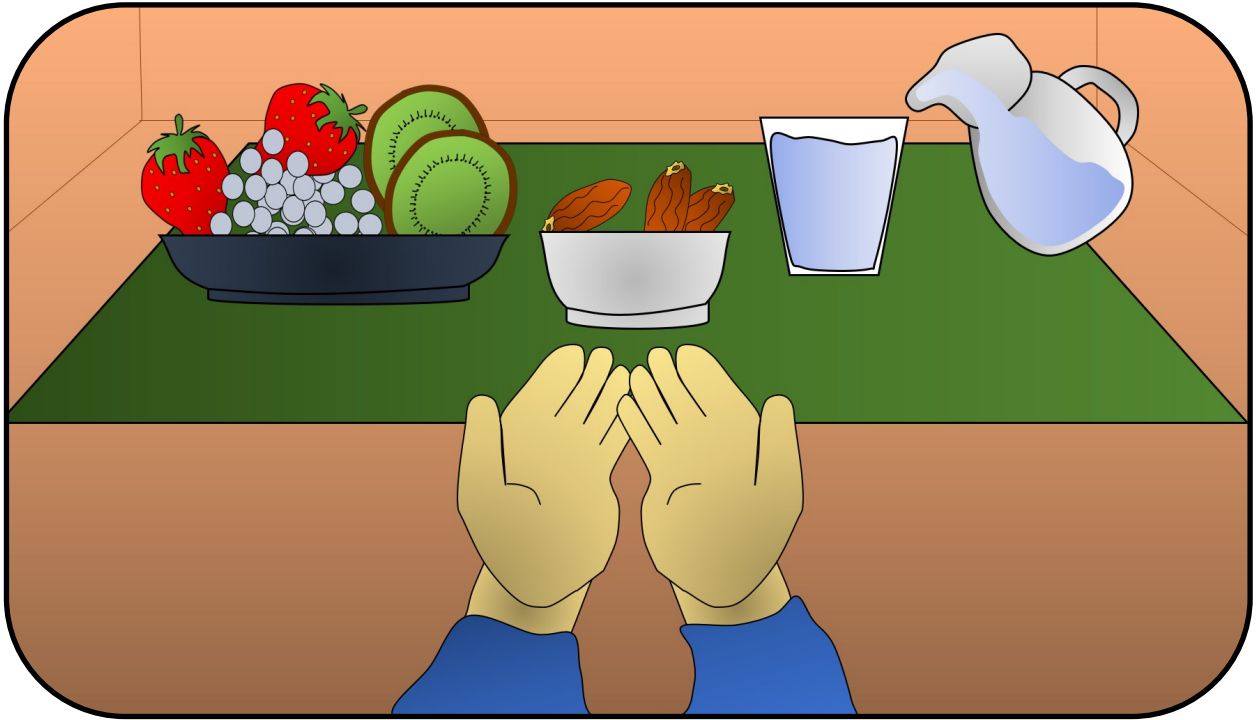
# Ramadan sentence tracing

than a thousand months.

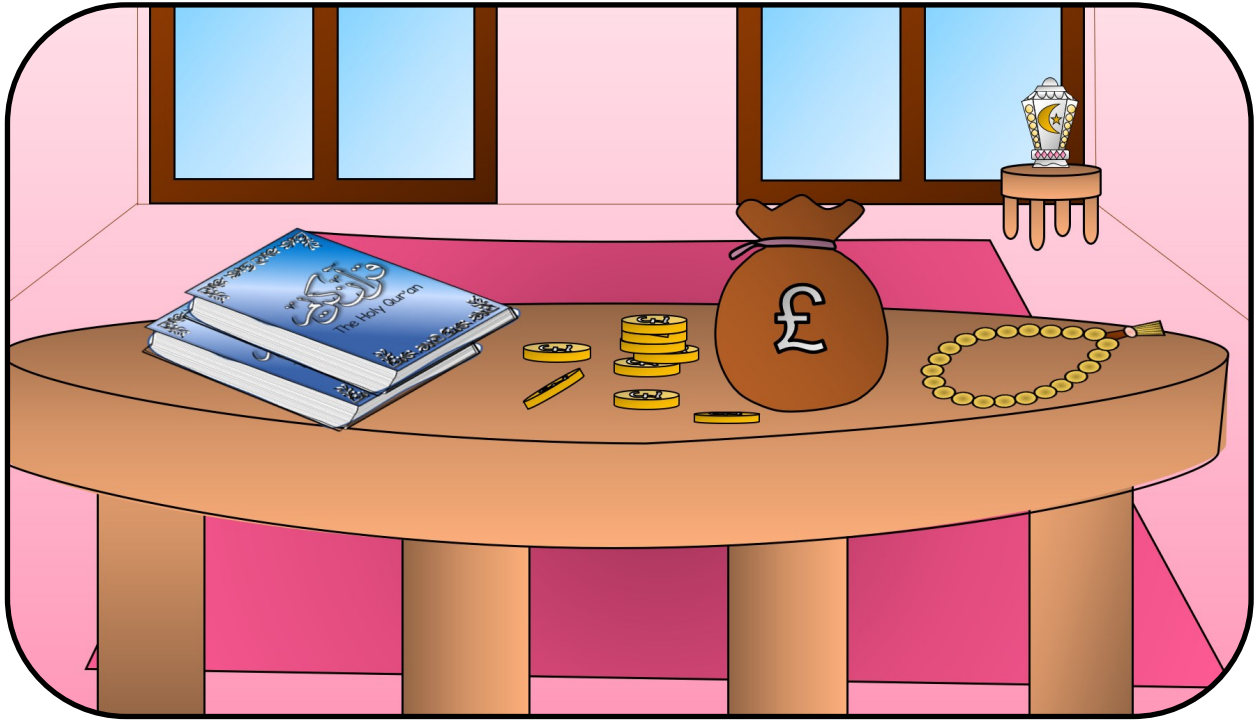


# Ramadan sentence tracing



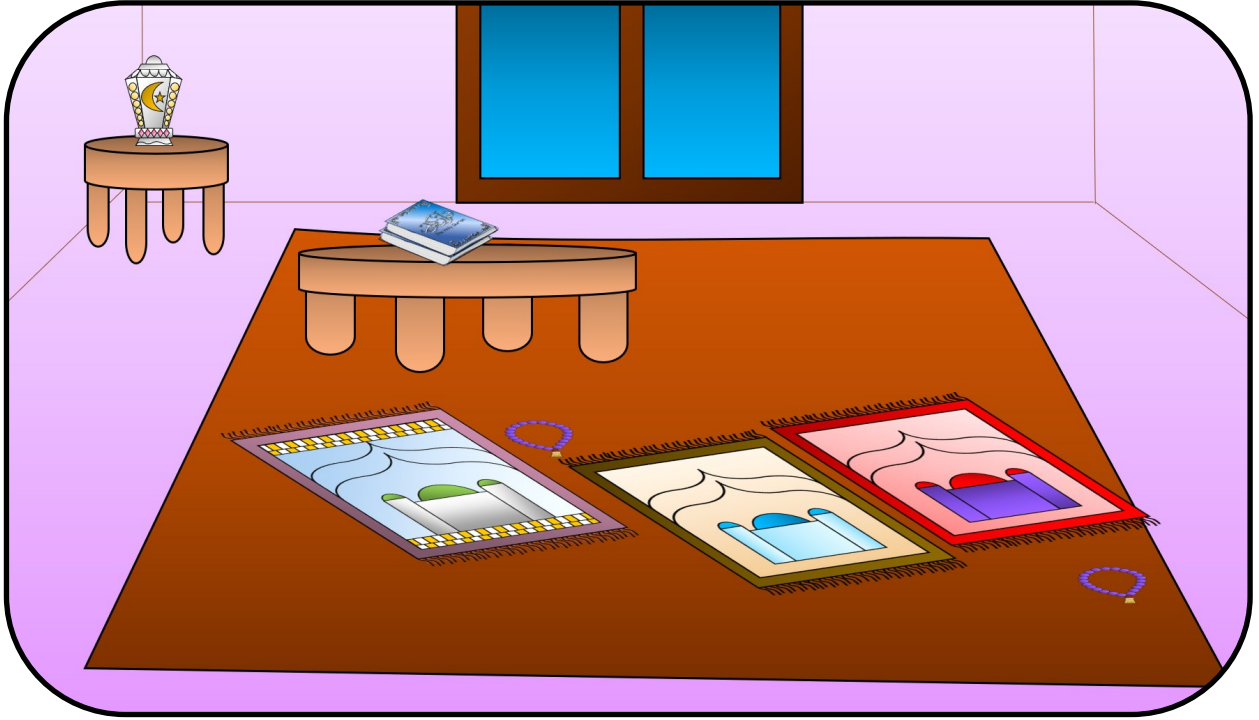
One of the best times to make

# Ramadan sentence tracing



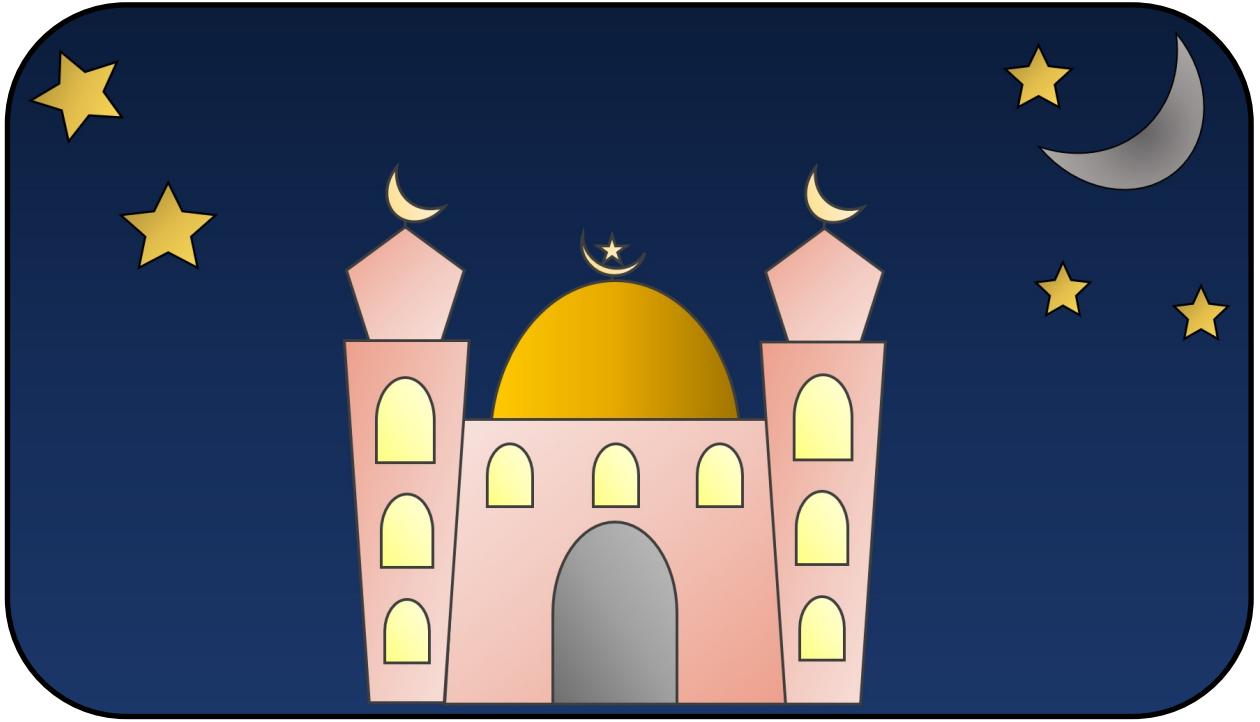
The reward for Sadaqah and

visiting the sick.

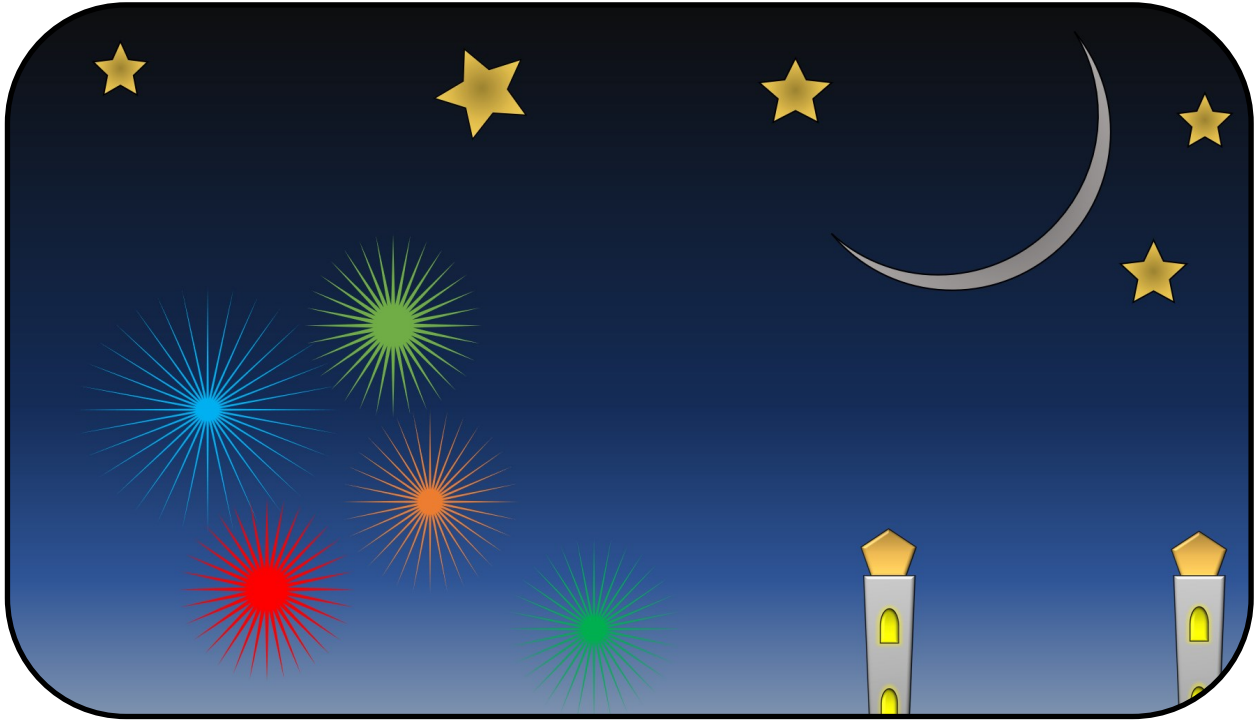
# Ramadan sentence tracing
