Eligibility Criteria for the Acquisition of the Encrypted Devices

Telecotel and Telecosec is a sovereign-grade encrypted communication device, reserved exclusively for high-level governmental entities, strategic institutions, and select individuals with a demonstrated record of sovereign, judicial, diplomatic, or executive authority. Access to the device is governed under a strict classification framework, and allocated only upon formal eligibility assessment and institutional endorsement.

Category I: Active Governmental Authorities and Strategic Institutions

This category is granted access to the full capabilities of the device including the embedded secure operating system and the externally paired encrypted audio communication headset (which remains exclusive to this category and is not issued separately to others).

Eligible entities include:

- National intelligence and security services
- Ministries of defence, interior, and justice
- Central banks and sovereign regulatory authorities
- National cyber defence and critical communications bodies
- Diplomatic missions, sovereign delegations, and government-linked critical infrastructure bodies

Eligible individuals (in active duty or appointment):

- Senior military officers of general command rank
- Constitutional and supreme court judges
- Ministers and deputy heads of state
- Sitting members of national parliaments or senates
- Diplomats and envoys currently serving under official assignment
- Governors or executive leadership of sovereign financial institutions

Requirements:

- Official governmental endorsement issued directly by the relevant authority
- Individual clearances where applications are made on a personal basis
- Binding commitment to sovereign-use limitations and operational compliance

> Note: The secure headset shall not be distributed independently or for individual use outside of this

Category II: Former High-Ranking Officials and Recognised Executive Figures

This category may be granted access to the Telecotel device with full encryption and a sealed operating environment, but without the external audio encryption headset.

Eligible individuals include:

- Former ministers, judges, and diplomats of senior rank
- Retired senior military officers
- Former members of national parliaments with verified executive capacity
- High-ranking executives of financial or strategic institutions with formal sovereign engagement
- Individuals with substantiated historical affiliation to national or supranational governance bodies

Requirements:

- Documentation verifying former executive or sovereign standing
- Official recommendation from a recognised governmental or regulated financial institution
- Formal approval by the Governance Board of The Zein Group Holding Company

Non-Transferability and Legal Enforcement

The resale, transfer, or unauthorised distribution of the Telecotel device or any of its components in whole or in part is strictly prohibited under all circumstances. No exemption or negotiation shall be entertained.

Any violation will be treated as a breach of sovereign technology regulation and shall trigger:

- Immediate legal action, regardless of the violators status or former rank
- Blacklisting across all The Zein Group Holding Company systems and affiliates
- Formal coordination with competent national authorities, potentially under counter-terrorism and unlawful technology dissemination statutes
- Direct liability under pre-signed contractual obligations, inclusive of clauses pertaining to sovereign device abuse and international financial misconduct
