- Additional investment on Chapel Walk and in Orchard Square



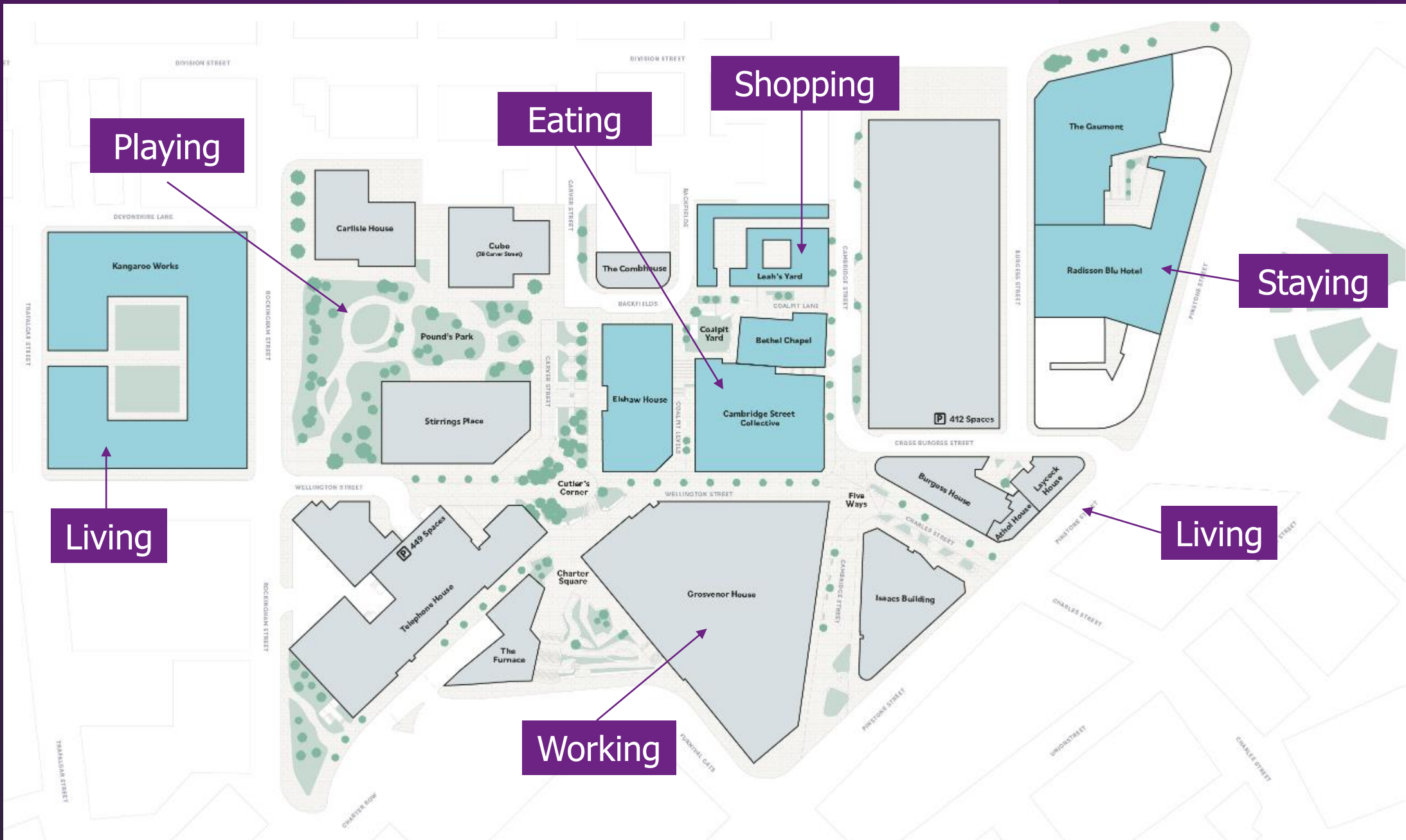
Heart of the City

- Followed by a second office building and a 450+ space multi-storey car park.



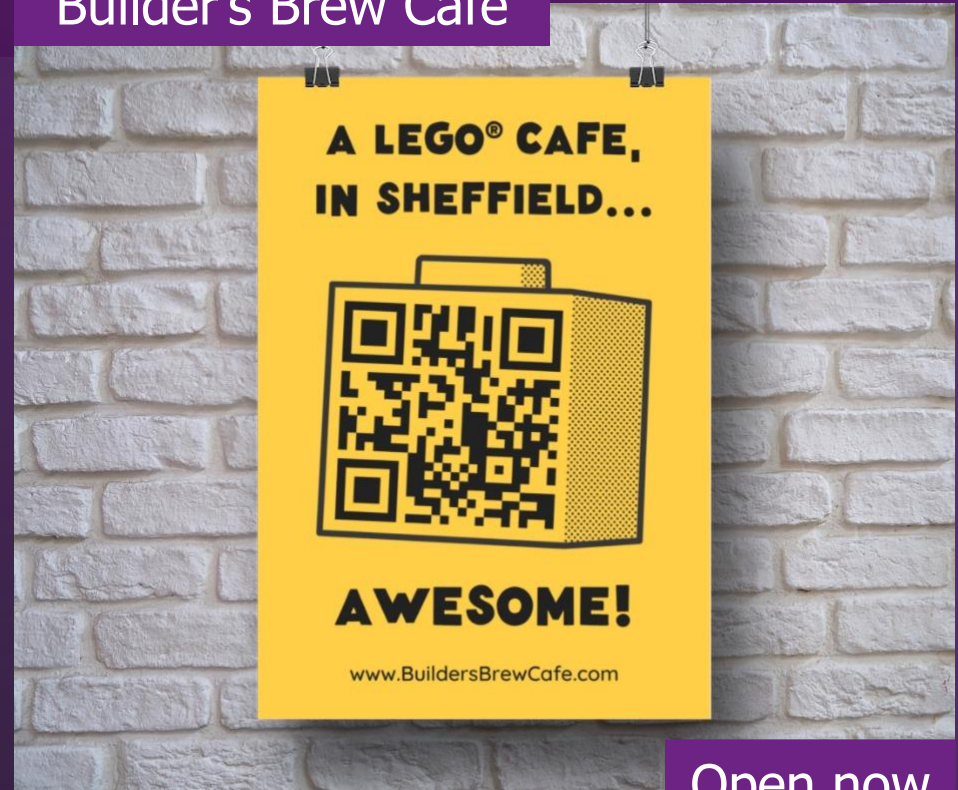
