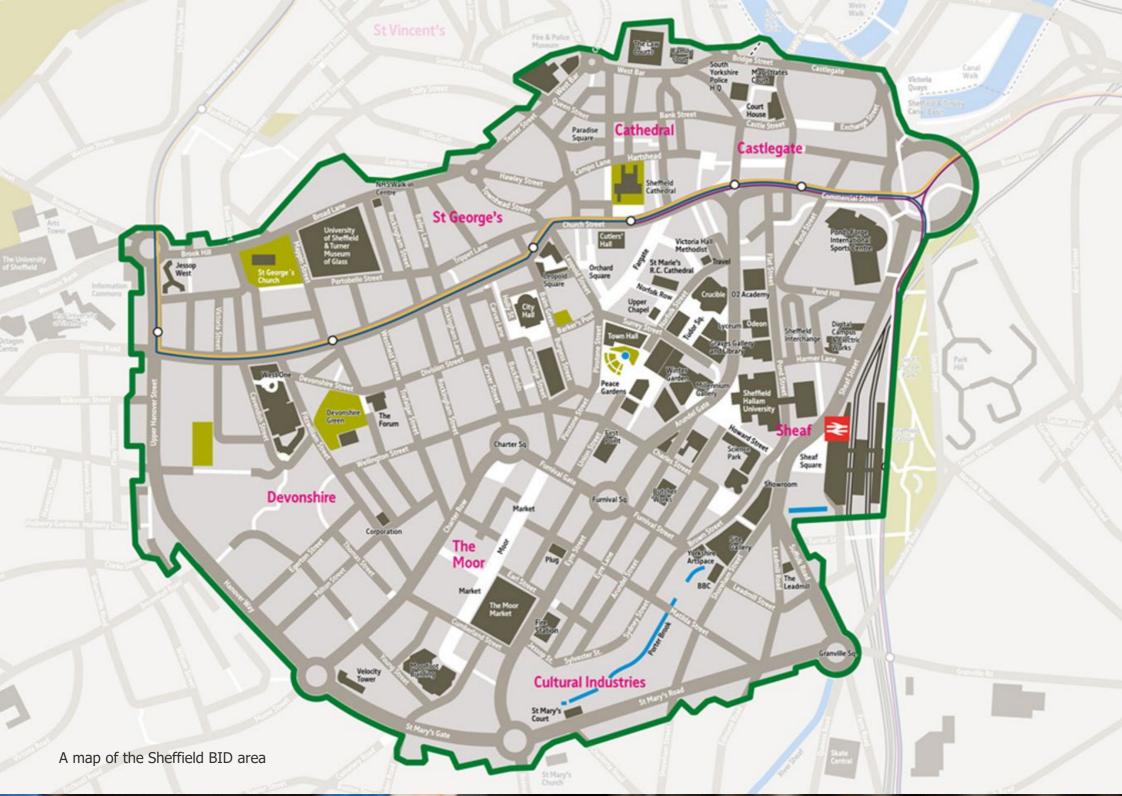

# **Trends and insights**

## **Sheffield city centre**

## **Dec 2024**





- In Dec 2024, monthly retail sales in Sheffield city centre were £25.9m. Year-to-Date (YTD) sales were £230m.
- Compared to Dec 2023, monthly sales marginally decreased by -0.9%. while YTD sales decreased by -2.7%.
- The marginal decrease in monthly sales was due to a decrease of -5.1% in customer numbers and an increase of +4.4% in the average revenue per customer (ARPC).

## **Sales growth**

#### Sheffield city centre v. comparator areas

- Monthly sales change between Dec 2023 and Dec 2024 in Sheffield (-0.9%) is higher than Nottingham (-6.1%) and Leeds (-6.4%).
- YTD sales change between Dec 2023 and Dec 2024 in Sheffield (-2.7%) is similar to Leeds (-3.0%) and lower than Nottingham (-1.0%).

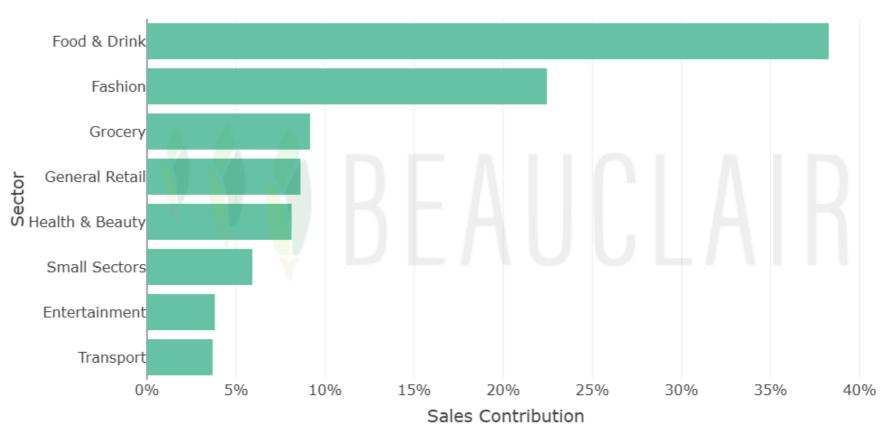
### **Sector sales**

- The five sectors with the highest monthly sales are Food & Drink (£9.91m), Fashion (£5.82m), Grocery (£2.37m), General Retail (£2.23m), and Health & Beauty (£2.10m).
- The five sectors with the highest YTD sales are Food & Drink (£89.1m), Fashion (£46.4m), Grocery (£24.2m), Health & Beauty (£21.5m), and General Retail (£16.5m).
- The five sectors showing the largest change in sales between Dec 2023 and Dec 2024 are Household (+£399k), Health & Beauty (-£321k), Fashion (-£294k), Grocery (+£170k), and Transport (-£146k).

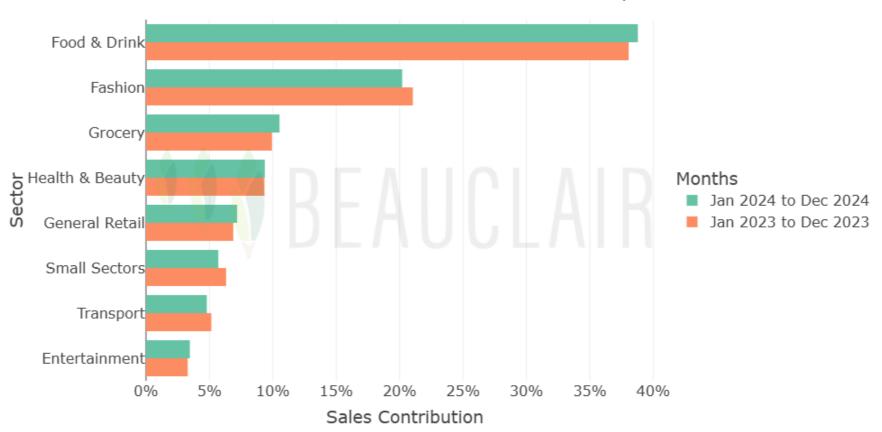

Sheffield - Sector Sales Contribution - Dec 2024

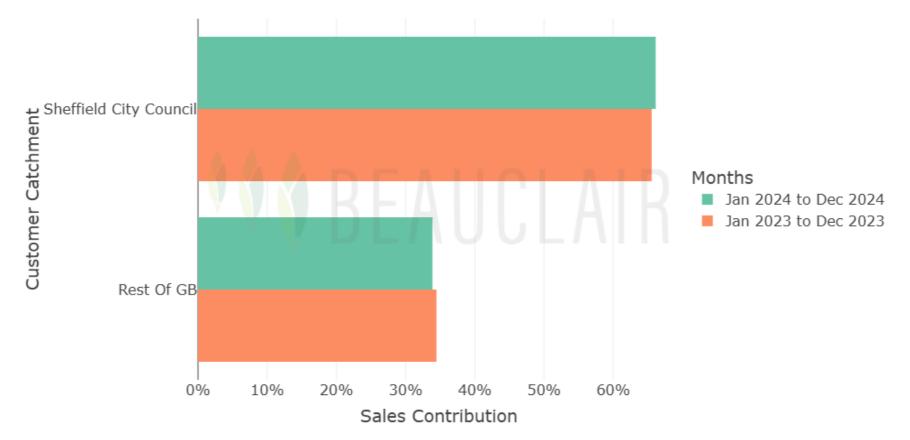

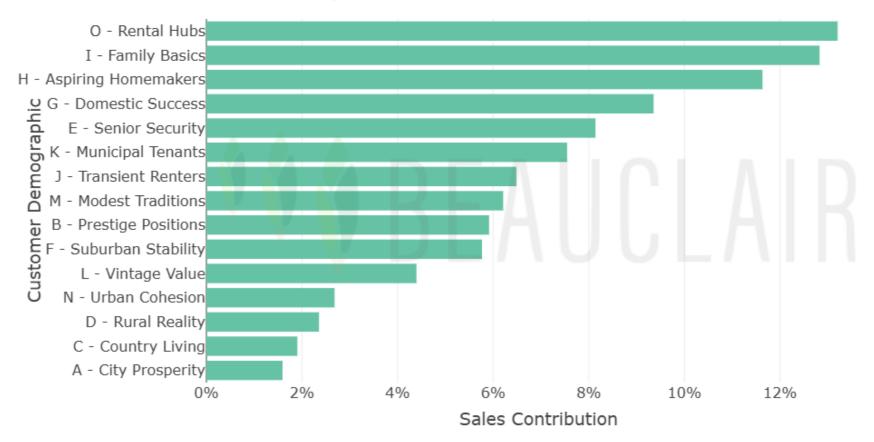
