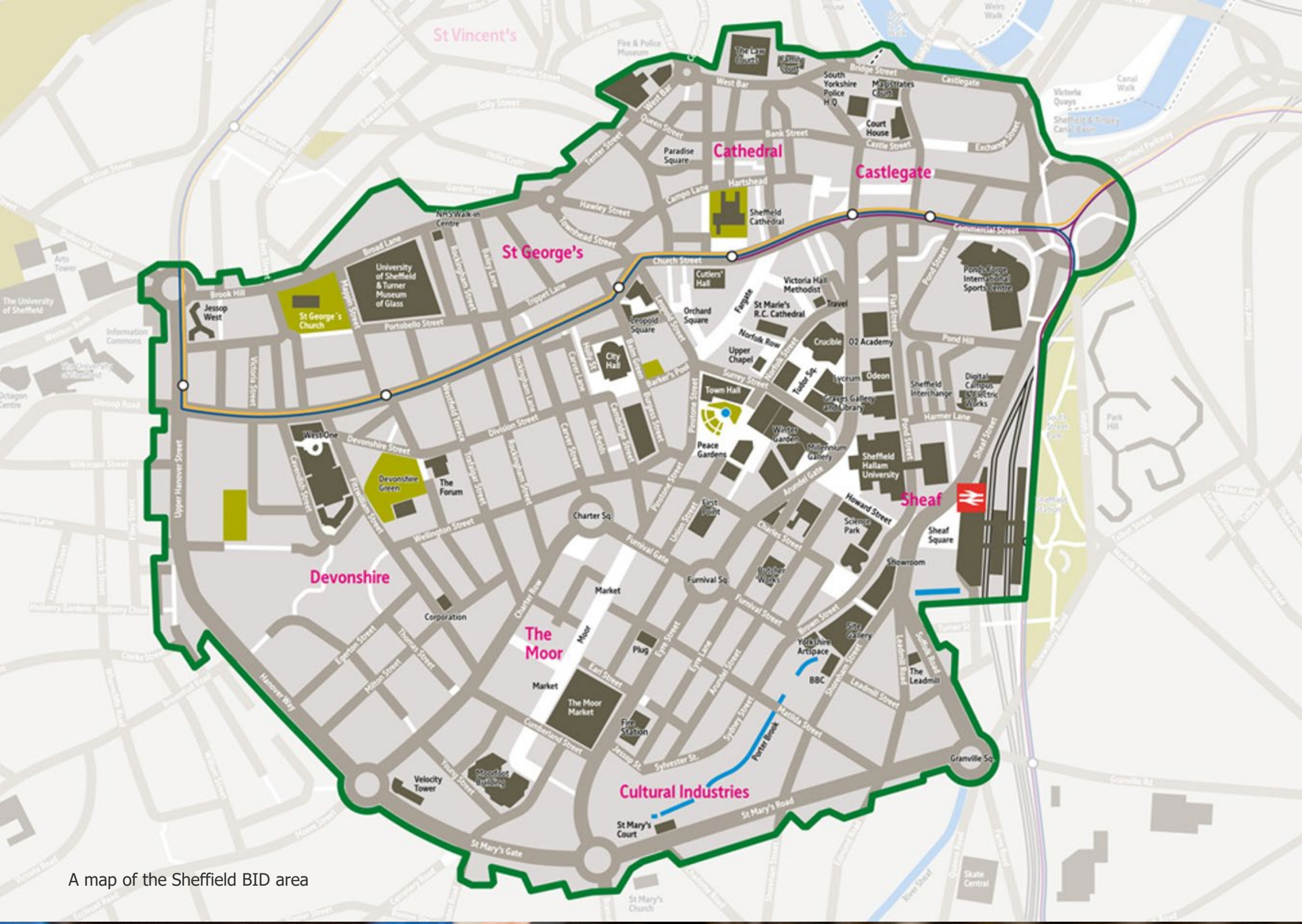

Five months of growth, one month of pause

The latest **BID Barometer** highlights a strong start to 2025 for Sheffield city centre, with five consecutive months of year-on-year growth in visitor spending:

- +3.1% in January
- +0.6% in February
- +3.4% in March
- +1.9% in April
- +4.3% in May

Spending rose from **£16.8 million in January to £21.8 million** in May, a **30% increase** over five months.

This sustained growth reflects resilient consumer confidence and economic stability in the city centre, outperforming both regional and national benchmarks throughout the period.

However, June saw an 8.5% year-on-year decline, in line with a broader national trend. This drop is likely due to a combination of factors:

- Fewer Saturdays in June 2025 (four vs. five in 2024), coinciding with the absence of a key trading day during the half-term weekend.
- Hot weather, which may have drawn consumers away from the city centre to outdoor and coastal destinations.

Despite this seasonal dip, the overall trajectory for the first half of 2025 remains positive.

Key retail metrics – June 2025 (Sheffield city centre)

- In June 2025, monthly retail sales in Sheffield were £17.2m. Year-to-Date (YTD) sales were £111m.
- Compared to June 2024, monthly sales decreased by -8.6% while YTD sales were static.
- The decrease in monthly sales was due to a decrease of -10.4% in customer numbers and an increase of +2.1% in average revenue per customer (ARPC).

Sales growth – June 2025

Sheffield city centre v. comparator areas

- Monthly sales change between June 2024 and June 2025 in Sheffield (-8.6%) is similar to Leeds (-9.1%), and lower than Nottingham (-7.0%).
- YTD sales change between June 2024 and June 2025 in Sheffield (0.0%) is higher than Nottingham (-3.5%) and Leeds (-4.9%).

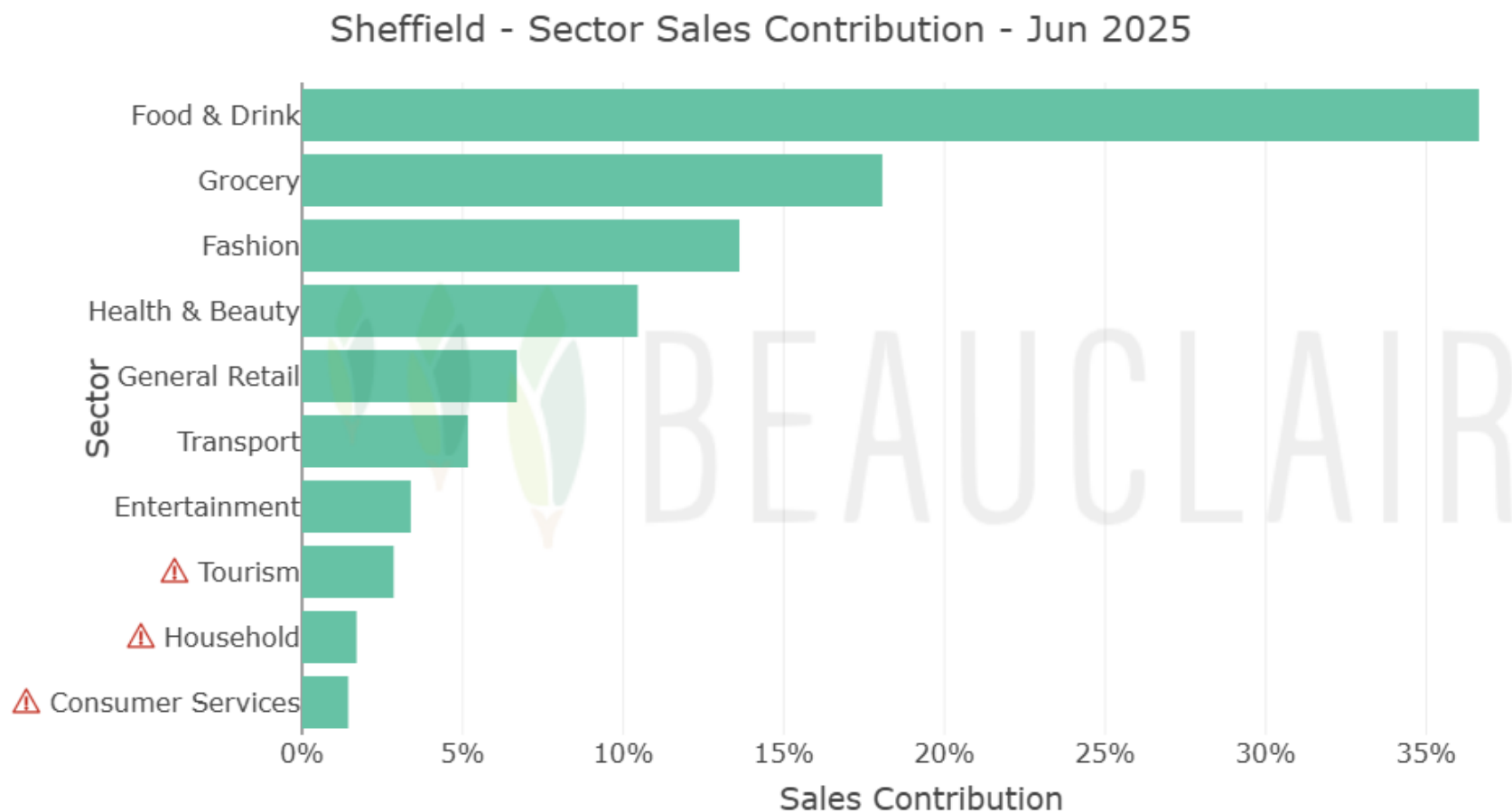
Sector sales – June 2025 (Sheffield city centre)

- The five sectors with the highest monthly sales are Food & Drink (£6.29m), Grocery (£3.10m), Fashion (£2.34m), Health & Beauty (£1.80m), and General Retail (£1.15m).
- The five sectors with the highest YTD sales are Food & Drink (£46.2m), Grocery (£19.2m), Fashion (£15.7m), Health & Beauty (£10.3m), and General Retail (£7.12m).
- The five sectors showing the largest change in sales between June 2024 and June 2025 are Food & Drink (-£1.23m), Fashion (-£427k), Health & Beauty (+£123k), Transport (-£59.0k) and General Retail (-£52.2k).

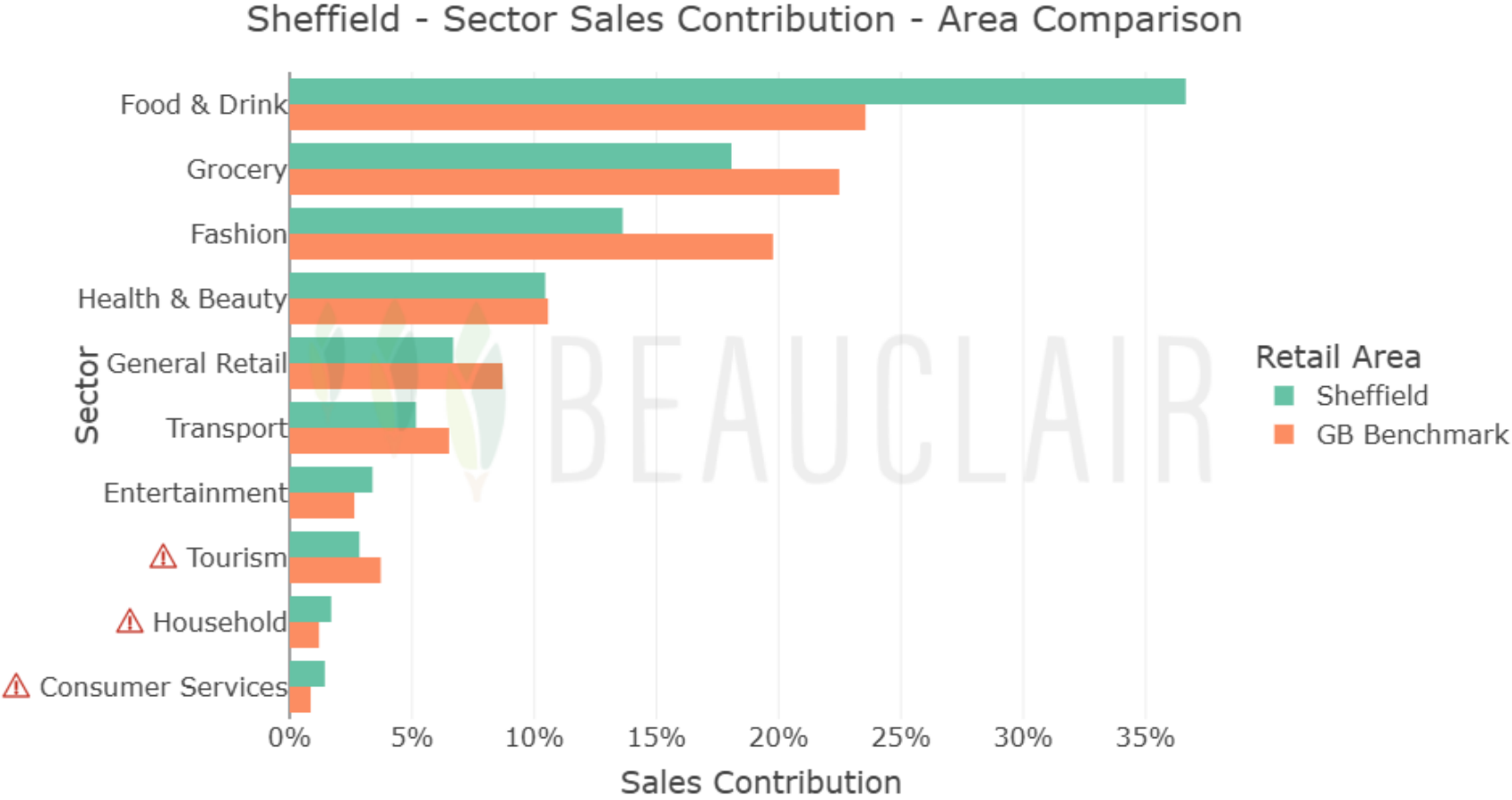

Sector sales – June 2025 (Sheffield city centre)



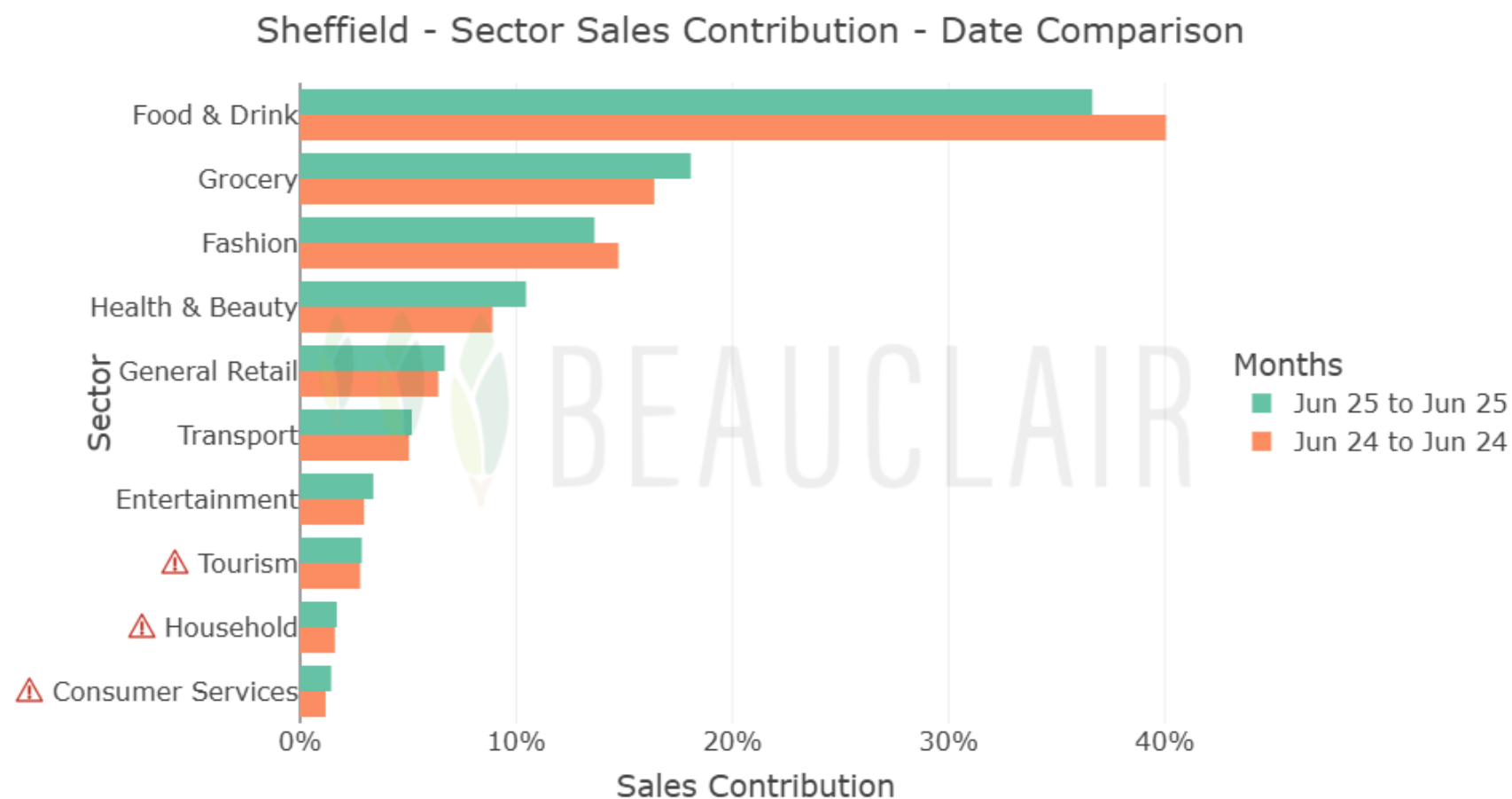

Sector sales – June 2025 (comparison vs GB Benchmark)



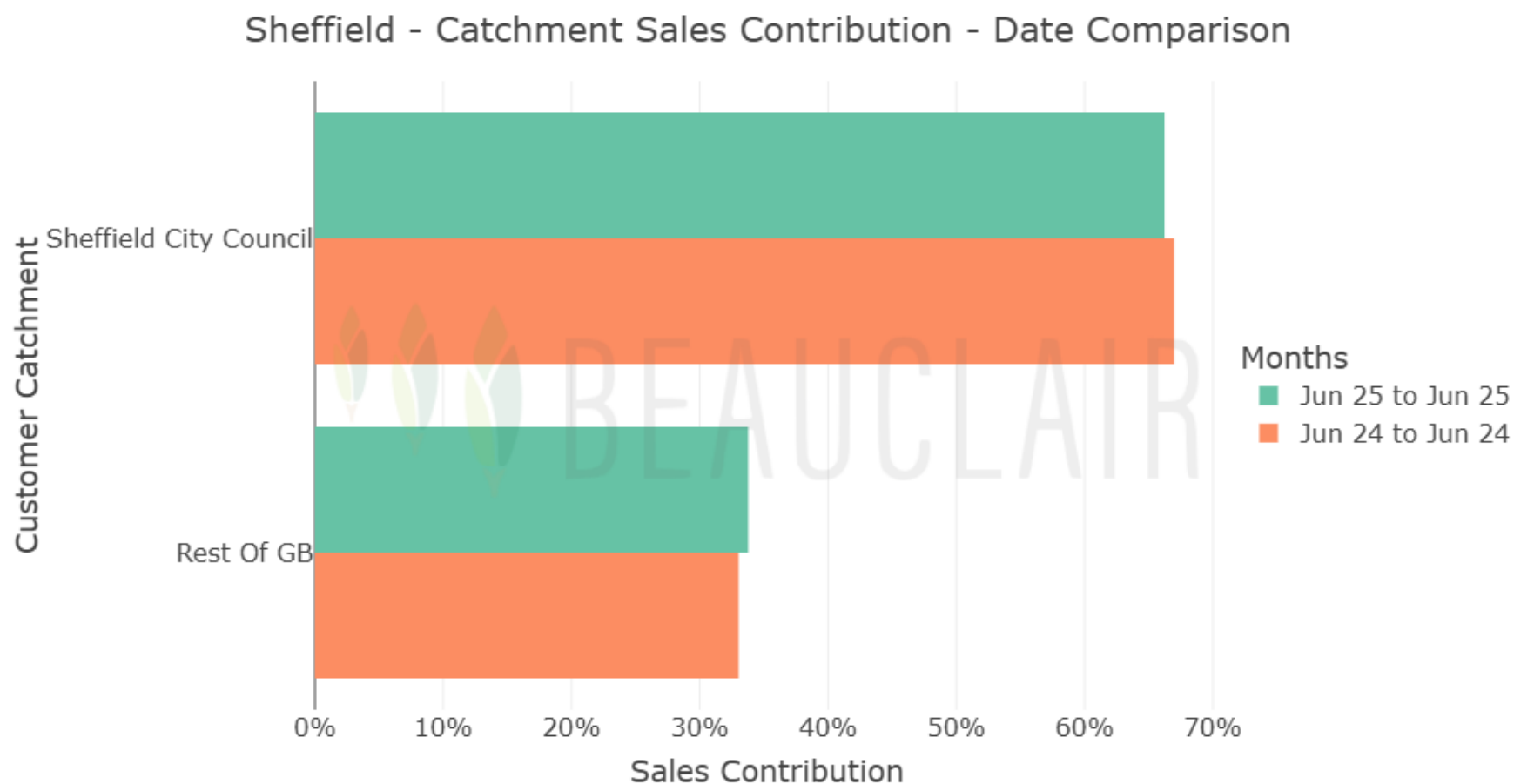

Sector sales – June 2025 v June 2024 (Sheffield city centre)

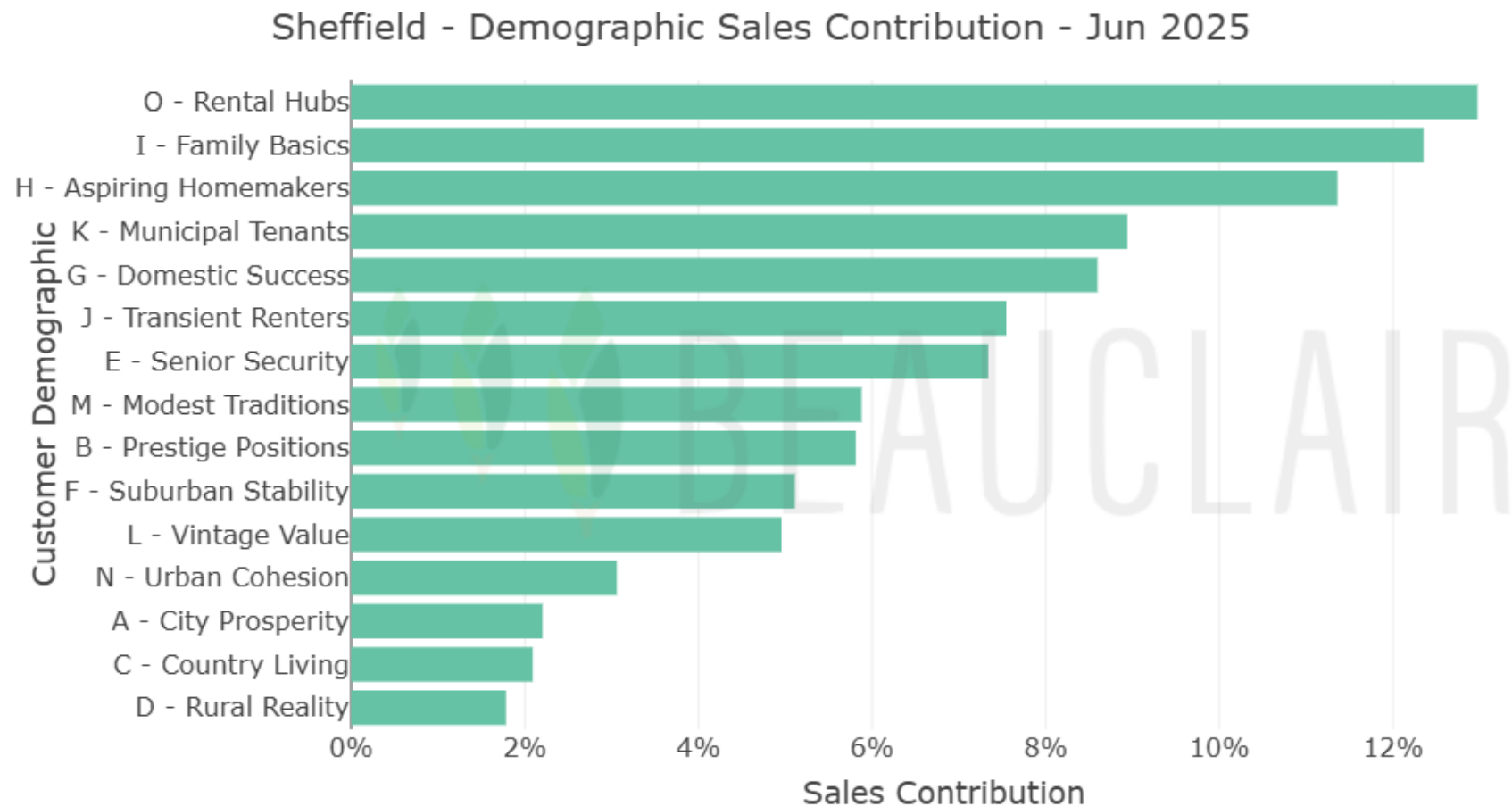

Catchment sales – June 2025 (Sheffield city centre)

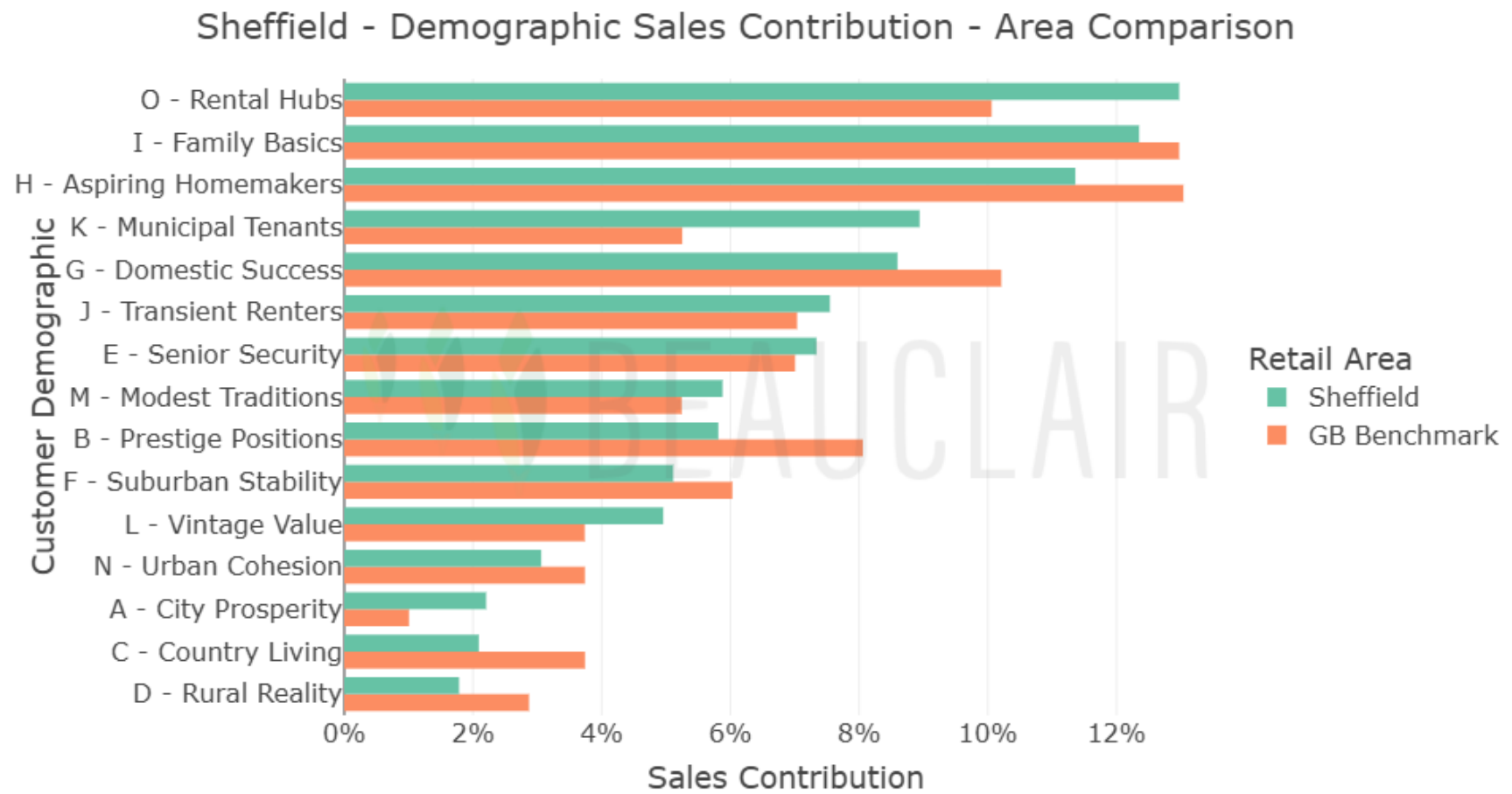

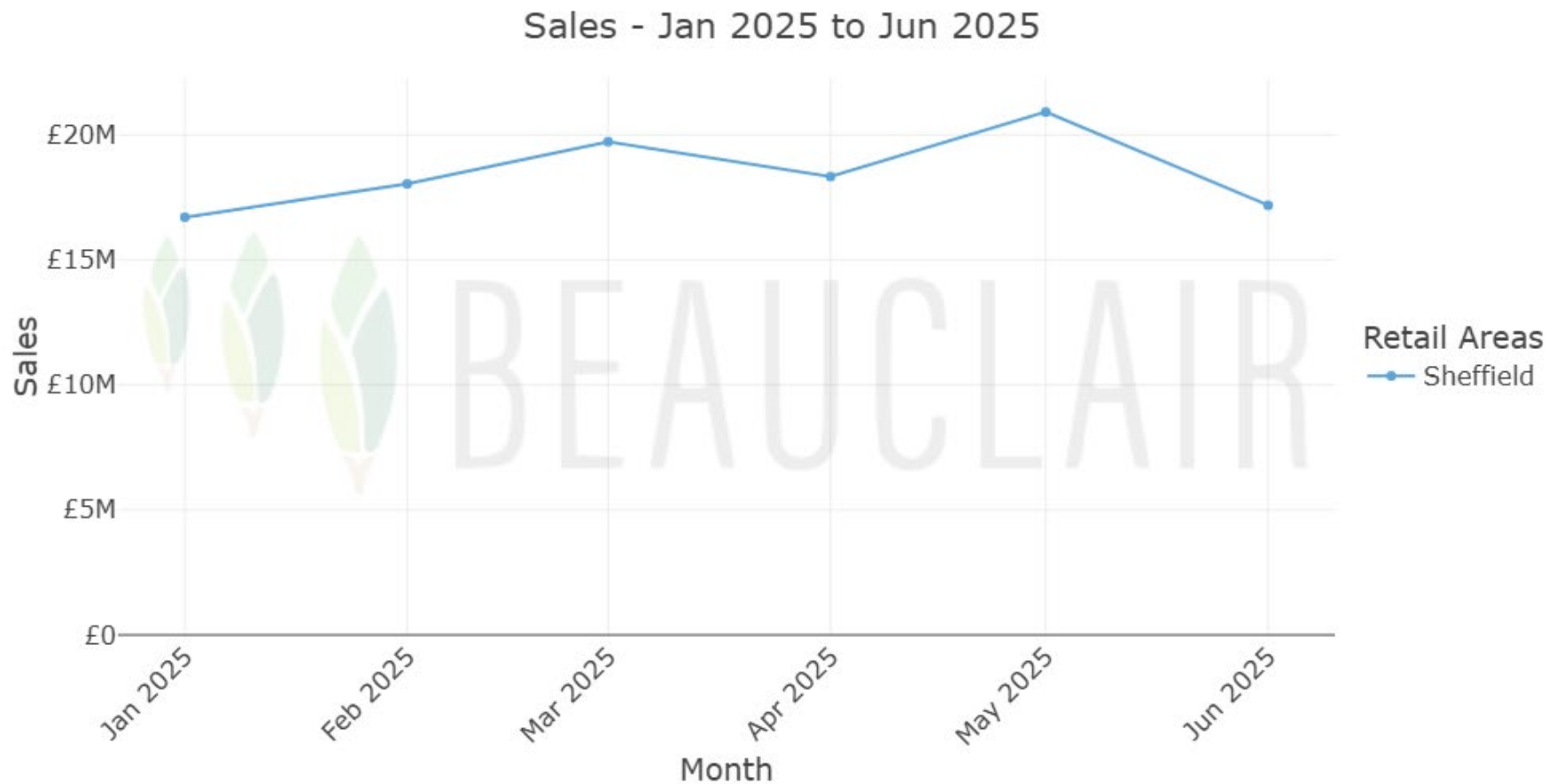
Customer demographics – June 2025 (comparison with GB Benchmark)

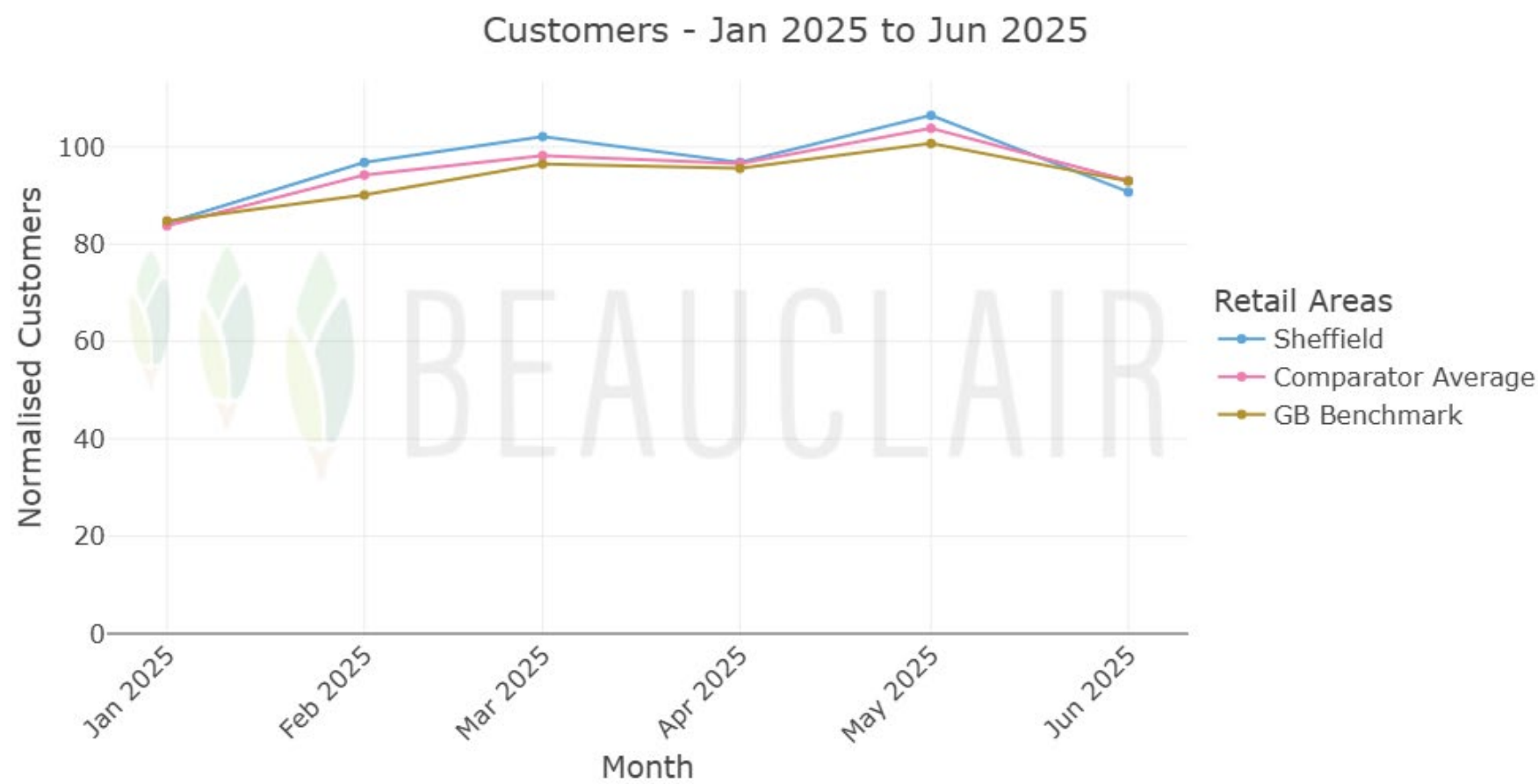
Sales – YTD 2025 (comparison vs GB Benchmark)



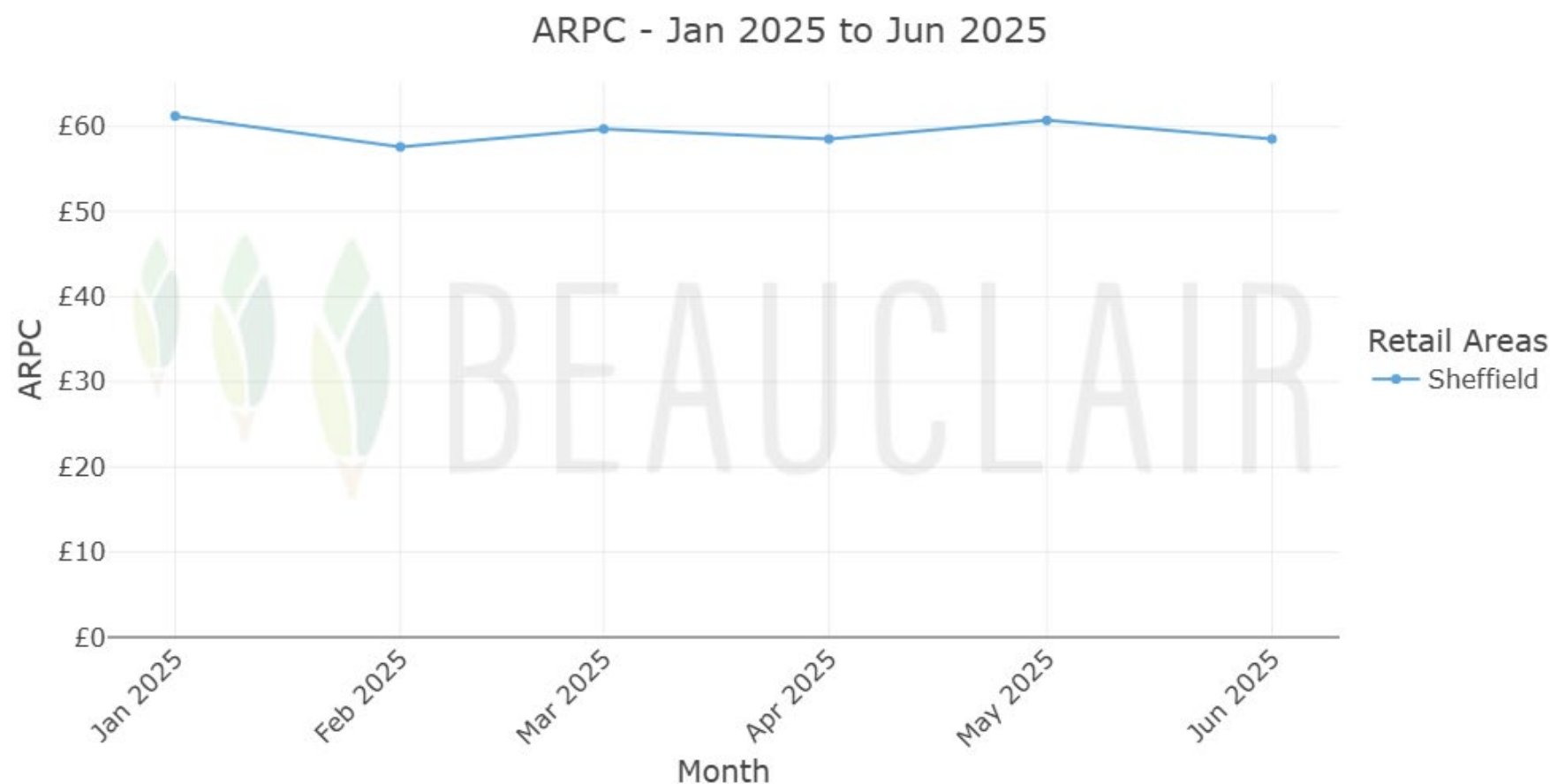
