Supporting small rural towns is a Daytripper speciality, and we'll do exactly this on this lovely get away to some of Northern Victoria's less visited areas.

Wedderburn is a rural township that was founded on a gold field, one of the most north-westerly gold sites from Melbourne. Magnificent buildings remain in the back blocks of Wedderburn just waiting to be explored.

Sea Lake is a wheat-belt town in the Victorian Mallee, located south of the shores of Lake Tyrrell (the largest lake in Victoria). It is defined by the large grain silos on Railway Avenue and the railway line that transports the wheat which surrounds the settlement.

Day 1: HOME TO WEDDERBURN

Welcome on board our 6-day tour to **Wedderburn & Sea Lake**. This morning we make our way South towards Wedderburn, stopping for **morning tea** along the way. We head to the **Ararat RSL** for a chance to stretch our legs and enjoy lunch before our visit to the **J Ward Museum**, Ararat's Goldfields Prison and Lunatic Asylum.
