Lastly, we visit the **Tungamah Silos**, which were the first silos to be painted in North East Victoria. We'll also learn about other murals painted around the town and try to locate them. After a day filled with art, we headed back to our motel to freshen up before enjoying a delightful two-course dinner together. A truly amazing day filled with art and good company!
