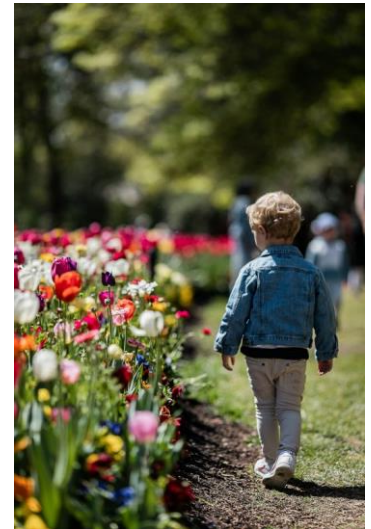

Day 1. Lakes Entrance

(L/D)

After being picked up from home by our private vehicles, we welcome you onboard. Relax in your comfortable coach seat and enjoy your extended leg room as we begin our journey along the coast towards Lakes Entrance, stopping for morning tea enroute before arrive at Rosedale with a visit to **Victoria Rose Tea Rooms** delightful old-world charm and enchanting rose gardens. Famous for its "**High Tea**" which we will enjoy for lunch. Add a glass of Bubbles to your lunch if you like (o/e). What a fancy way to start our tour! With full stomachs, we board the bus and head to **Historical Nyerimilang Homestead**. After enjoying our guided tour of this 19th century building, we make our way to our motel in Lakes Entrance – home for two nights. Day 5. Lake Burley Griffin

Another lovely breakfast this morning before we head to **Lake Burleigh Griffin**. We'll take a stroll along the **Australian of the Year walk** and look out at the **Captain James Cook memorial** before embarking our **morning tea cruise** on Lake Burleigh Griffin. Sit back and relax as we see the national capital sights from the water. Our afternoon takes us to **Cockington Green Gardens**, showcasing a delightful and fascinating display of meticulously crafted miniature buildings set within beautifully landscaped gardens. Whilst here we'll enjoy a light lunch before heading back to Canberra to experience the very moving **Last Post**. Tonight, we will enjoy a lovely **restaurant dinner** in the area before making our way back to our hotel.

Layers of flowers and colour are everywhere you turn, and each new space is as breathtakingly beautiful as the last. A lovely way to spend the afternoon. Heading back towards our hotel we stop at the **Mount Ainslie Lookout** for picture-perfect views of Canberra. We take in Lake Burley Griffin and many of Canberra's national attractions, framed by picturesque mountain ranges. Another delightful day in our nation's capital, we head back to our hotel to enjoy our final Canberra dinner together.

Day 7. Canberra to Wangaratta

The Museum houses an amazing display of photos and submarine memorabilia including authentic submarine escape suits, a torpedo and even a genuine Jolly Roger flag. We will enjoy a lovely lunch in town then head towards Wangaratta, home for the night. Arriving at one of our favourite hotels, Gateway Wangaratta, take time to relax before our farewell dinner at the hotels gorgeous **Atrium Restaurant**
