After the farm, take some time to explore the unique shops showcasing local crafts before indulging in a delicious lunch featuring fresh produce sourced right from the farm. In the afternoon, we'll take a leisurely stroll along the scenic boardwalk within Victoria Park Nature Reserve, reconnecting with nature. Our adventure continues as we head to Evans Head, where you can explore the impressive aircraft collection, including the F-111 Fighter Bomber, at the Evans Head Aviation **Museum**. Before we return to Ballina, don't miss the chance to soak in the stunning views from Razorback Lookout. After such a fulfilling day packed with exploration and experiences, we'll head back to the resort to relax and freshen up before enjoying a wonderful dinner together.
