This museum offers a window into the past with unique exhibitions, including the homemade snowshoes crafted by pioneering skiers and gold mining relics from the 1880s. After a satisfying lunch and some time to explore the charming village, we will begin our journey back to Bright. Our final stop will be **Gunnado Berries**, where we can indulge in homemade jams and have a heartfelt chat with Rocky. We'll conclude our day with a return to our motel for another exquisite dinner.



DAY 3: Historic Beechworth

Pepo Farms is Australia's first and only grower of pumpkin seeds and producer of fine artisan oils. Arriving in Beechworth, we step back in time with a guided tour of the fascinating **Old Beechworth Gaol**, rich with stories of bushrangers and bygone days. Afterwards, you'll have time to purchase lunch at one of the Gaols café before we continue to The **Beechworth Historic Precinct**, one of the best-preserved gold rush precincts in Australia, offering a fascinating step back into the 1850s. This beautifully maintained area features grand public buildings, tree-lined streets, and stories of gold, bushrangers and courtroom drama. Highlights within the precinct include the impressive **Beechworth Courthouse**, and a collection of historic hotels, churches and shops that still operate today. Our guided walk through the precinct brings to life tales of the gold rush era, infamous outlaws, and the pioneering spirit that shaped this remarkable High Country town. After a day immersed in history and heritage, we return to Bright for another delicious home-cooked dinner and a well-earned restful night.

DAY 4: Beautiful Bright
