Day 1 – Sunday 15 November – Home to Horsham

(L/D)

Welcome to our 8-day Adelaide, Murray Bridge, Kangaroo Island & *The Overland* Train tour! We have a scenic travel day ahead as we journey towards **Ballarat**, where we enjoy a delicious light lunch at the **Beechworth Bakery**. From here we travel on to **Ararat**, a charming historic gold-mining town and the only town in Australia founded by Chinese miners. Here we enjoy a guided tour of the fascinating **J Ward**, hearing stories from its days as a gaol housing murderers and thieves, and later as an institution for the criminally insane. We then continue to nearby **Horsham**, known as the capital of the Wimmera. After checking in, there's time to relax and freshen up before gathering for our welcome dinner in the hotel restaurant.

Accommodation: Best Westlander Motor Inn, Horsham – 1 night

Day 2 – Monday 16 November - Horsham to Murray Bridge

After breakfast, we depart Horsham, stopping along the way for our morning break before arriving in **Keith** for lunch at the Keith Hotel Motel. This afternoon we visit **Old Tailem Town Pioneer Village**, one of Australia's largest and most impressive open-air museums. With more than 90 historic buildings spread across twelve streets, this immersive village offers a wonderful glimpse into Australia's past — from shops and cottages to the hospital and local pub. We then make our way to **Murray Bridge** for our overnight stay, with time to settle in before dinner.

Accommodation: Bridgeport Hotel, Murray Bridge – 1 night

Day 3 - Tue 17 November – Exploring Adelaide

After breakfast, we head into the **Adelaide Hills** to visit **Hahndorf**, Australia's oldest surviving German settlement. Enjoy free time to explore the charming main street, lined with cafes, bakeries, shops and pubs, and purchase lunch at your leisure. We then enjoy a guided tour of **The Cedars**, the home and studio of renowned artist Sir Hans Heysen, set among beautiful gardens. Later we visit **Melba's Chocolate & Confectionery Factory** to watch artisans at work — tasting is encouraged! We also stop at **Woodside Cheese Wrights** for a sampling of their handcrafted cheeses. On our way to Adelaide, we pause at **Mount Lofty Lookout** to take in panoramic views across the city and coastline. Dinner tonight is at the hotel restaurant.

Day 4 – Wed 18 November – to Kangaroo Island (B/L/D)

An early start today as we travel to Cape Jervis to board the ferry to Penneshaw on **Kangaroo Island**. On arrival, we begin exploring the picturesque **Dudley Peninsula**. Our first stop is **Dudley Wines**, where we enjoy stunning coastal views, a **wine tasting**, and a **delicious lunch**. We then head to **Rob's Shearing & Sheepdogs** for a truly authentic Australian experience. Rob and his hardworking kelpies demonstrate sheepdog mustering, yarding, shearing, wool classing and hand spinning, all shared in an entertaining and down-to-earth way. Later this afternoon we travel to **Kingscote**, the island's main town, where we check in to our accommodation for the next three nights.

Day 5 – Thursday 19 November – Kangaroo Island Produce (B/L/D)


Today we discover some of Kangaroo Island's unique local produce. Our first stop is **Clifford's Honey Farm**, home to the island's famous Ligurian bees — a pure strain introduced from Italy in the 1880s and protected by the island's isolation. We continue to **Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Distillery** for a guided tour, learning about Australia's first major export and one of Kangaroo Island's key industries. Next, we visit **Emu Bay Lavender Farm**, where lunch is followed by a tour of the 51-acre property featuring over 7,500 lavender plants across 12 varieties. This afternoon we visit **Kangaroo Island Wool** for an immersive mill experience, beginning with a cinematic presentation inside Australia's only 9-metre Igloo Dome. Learn the story of the island's wool industry, from early settlers to modern-day farmers. After a full and fascinating day, we return to the Inn for dinner.

Meals: Breakfast & dinner at hotel | Light lunch at Emu Bay Lavender Farm

Day 6 – Friday 20 November - The Wilderness of Kangaroo Island (B/L/D)

Today is all about wildlife and natural wonders. We begin with a guided visit to **Seal Bay**, where we walk on the beach among a colony of **Australian Sea Lions**. Accompanied by our guide, we experience these magnificent animals up close as they rest on the sand. Next, we visit **Raptor Domain** for an impressive birds-of-prey free-flight demonstration, followed by lunch. This afternoon we travel to **Flinders Chase National Park**, exploring iconic landmarks including **Remarkable Rocks** and **Admirals Arch**. From the boardwalks, we can also see a **colony of New Zealand Fur Seals** below. A truly exceptional day of unforgettable wildlife experiences.

Day 7 – Saturday 21 November – Kangaroo Island to Adelaide

(B/L/D)

We farewell Kangaroo Island this morning as we return by ferry to the mainland. From here, we travel to the world-famous **wine region of McLaren Vale**. We enjoy lunch at **Wirra Wirra Vineyards**, renowned for its historic ironstone buildings and welcoming atmosphere. After lunch, we stop at the nearby **Menz FruChocs shop** — the perfect place to stock up on iconic South Australian treats. Arriving at our hotel, we have time to unpack and relax a little. This evening we're in for a treat as we head to **Glenelg Beach** to enjoy dinner right on the beach at the **Surf Lifesaving Club**. Afterwards we can take a stroll along the beach front. Those who are feeling adventurous might like to take a ride on the **Giant Ferris Wheel** located on the foreshore. What a view!!

Day 8 – Sunday 22 November - The Overland Train
