### **DAY 2: Bright & Harrietville**

**(B/MT/D)**

After a **hearty cooked breakfast**, we travel to the charming village of **Harrietville**. Nestled beside the Ovens River, our first stop is the beautiful **Shady Brook Cottage Garden**. Enjoy a guided tour through these stunning gardens, followed by a delightful light morning tea in peaceful surrounds. Returning to Bright, we discover the highlights of this much-loved Alpine town with a guided tour. A visit to **Nightingale Bros Orchard** provides the opportunity to sample some of the region's freshest produce and learn about local fruit growing traditions. There will be free time to explore Bright at your own pace, browse the shops, or purchase lunch. Later, we delve into the area's fascinating past at the **Bright Museum** before enjoying the creative displays at the **Bright Art Gallery**. This evening, return to the motel for another delicious home-cooked dinner.



### **DAY 3: Historic Beechworth**

**(B/L/D)**

Today's journey takes us to one of Victoria's most historic towns, with a unique stop along the way at **Pepo Farms**. Australia's only grower of pumpkin seeds and producer of artisan pumpkin seed oils, Pepo Farms offers a fascinating insight into this innovative local business, complete with tastings and demonstrations. Upon arrival in Beechworth, we step back in time with a **guided tour** of the famous **Old Beechworth Gaol**, where stories of bushrangers, gold rush characters and infamous inmates come to life. Following lunch, we explore the beautifully preserved **Beechworth Historic Precinct**. With its grand buildings, tree-lined streets and remarkable gold rush heritage, Beechworth offers one of Australia's finest glimpses into the 1850s. Highlights include the historic courthouse, heritage hotels, churches and charming shops, all woven together with tales of pioneers, bushrangers and courtroom drama. After a wonderful day of history and heritage, we return to Bright for dinner and a restful evening.

### **DAY 4: Mount Beauty & Dederang**

**(B/L/D)**

After breakfast, we travel through magnificent High Country scenery to **Mount Beauty**, where spectacular views of the **Bogong High Plains** await. A visit to the local Visitor Information Centre provides fascinating insights into the area's history, environment and attractions. We then continue to the beautifully renovated **Dederang Hotel**, now owned by Australian actor Shane Jacobson. Enjoy a **leisurely lunch** and time to explore this welcoming country pub. This afternoon, we visit the popular **Red Stag Deer and Emu Farm**. Meet the majestic red deer, friendly goats, playful pigs and other resident animals while enjoying the picturesque rural setting. Returning to Bright, another of Emma's delicious home-cooked dinners awaits.



### **DAY 5: Bright to Home**

After breakfast, we farewell our wonderful hosts and begin our journey home. Our first stop is **Little Cedar Farmhouse**, where we enjoy a relaxing morning tea before continuing to the beautiful **Yarra Valley**. Here we'll savour a delicious farewell **lunch at Killara Estate**, surrounded by vineyard views. With wonderful memories of colourful landscapes, charming country towns and great company, we then make our way home, where our chauffeur service will **return you right to your doorstep**.
