Japanese or Korean:

1. Write in Japanese (or Korean)
2. Write in romaji.
3. Write the English translation.

Example in Japanese:

石段を	<i>ishidan o</i>
爪先あがり	<i>tsumasaki agari</i>
夕時雨	<i>yuushigure</i>

I tiptoe up the stone steps in the evening rain.

中文・ can write in 3-4-3 structure

Chinese (3-4-3):

1. Write in Chinese.
2. Write in Roman characters 拉丁字母 .
3. Write the English translation.

Example:

幽静处	<i>Yōu jìng chù</i>
月光洒照花	<i>Yuè guāng sǎ zhào huā</i>
夜微冷	<i>Yè wēi lěng</i>

*Serene place
Moonlight pours, shines on flowers
Night slightly cold*

Alphabet languages (abc ...) (Deutsch/Español/Française/Polski/etc. ...)

Directions (5-7-5):

1. Write in the language.
2. Write the English translation.

Example in French:

Mes yeux se ferment
Le jour s'en va, je m'endors
Douce lassitude

My eyes close
The day fades, I fall asleep
Sweet weariness

Try writing *haiku*
It helps with mental focus
Submit it next week

5 I came to Jap-an
7 to get a-way from my life
