#### **CLINICAL HIGHLIGHTS**





In 2020 our preschool mental health services expanded to Head Start Preschools across the county.

Today our preschool consultation services are provided through our "ECC" (Early Childhood Consultation) program that serves Head Start across Contra Costa County.
