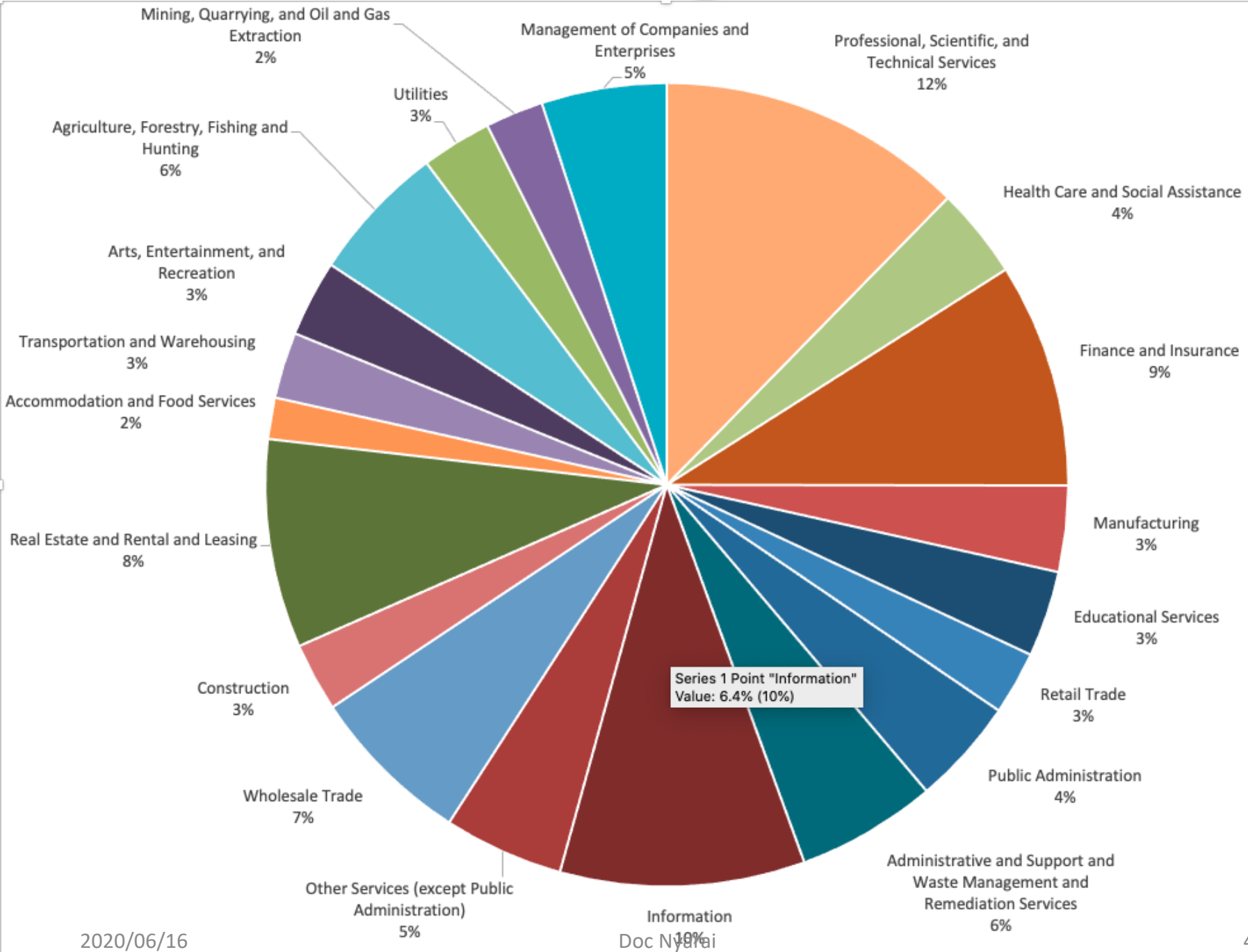
Definition

Telecommuting refers to a working arrangement or work style where an employee does his or her work off-site, or outside of the principal office.

They typically work from home one or more days a week and communicate with the office over the phone or some other internet-related form, like chat or email.

Telecommuting Trends

- 5 million employees (3.6% of the U.S. employee workforce) currently *Analysis of 2018 American Community Service (ACS) data*
- Regular work-at-home has grown 173% since 2005 — growing due to pandemic restrictions
- 43% of employees work remotely

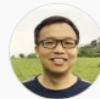
