BEFORE COMPLETING THE BOOKING FORM PLEASE READ THIS DOCUMENT CAREFULLY

Weddings in St Patrick's Parish must be booked at least six months in advance of the wedding

Congratulations!

Congratulations on your decision to Marry! Please read this document carefully and if you are happy to proceed please complete the **Booking Request Form and other documentation** which you should return to Fr Kieran at the address given overleaf.

Civil Requirements

You must give at least three months **Notice to the State.** (See list of Registrar Offices overleaf). **However we would advise that you do this straight away.**

You will need to make an appointment to meet in person with any Civil Registrar to give notice of your intention to marry.

Among the documentation / details you will need to bring once you get an appointment are

- Photo Identity (preferably a passport or driving license)
- Names and Dates of Birth of witnesses
- Name of Church where you wish to be married
- Date of Marriage
- Name of Priest who will officiate at the Marriage
- Fee

You will be issued with a **Marriage Registration Form.** You will need to bring your Marriage Registration Form (in the green folder) with you when you meet Fr Kieran to fill in your Church Papers. You are also responsible for returning the signed marriage Registration Form to the Office of the Register. This has to be done within one month of the Wedding.

If one or both of you are currently living outside the state an application form must be obtained from the Registrars Office, then completed and returned to that Office. You must present yourselves before the Registrar at least 5 days before the Wedding. You will be given the Registration Form, which you must present to the Marriage Solemniser (Priest), otherwise the marriage cannot be registered.



Church Requirements for your Wedding

Being Free to Marry in the Roman Catholic Church

To be married in the Roman Catholic Church at least one party to the proposed marriage **must be Catholic, be both adults, 18 yrs or older.** Couples seeking to book one of our Churches must complete the **declaration confirming their freedom to marry.** Should a canonical or legal impediment arise the wedding cannot take place.

Regarding the Priest Officiating at your Wedding

BEFORE YOUR BOOKING CAN BE ACCEPTED YOU MUST HAVE CONTACTED THE PRIEST WHO YOU WISH TO CELEBRATE YOUR WEDDING MASS TO ENSURE HE IS AVAILABLE. HIS NAME MUST BE ON THE BOOKING FORM.

COUPLES FROM OUTSIDE THE PARISH MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN PRIEST

If you are a parishioner and require Fr Kieran our parish Team Leader to celebrate your wedding please contact him at the contact details given below. You are also very welcome to have a priest who is a relative or family friend celebrate your wedding. Please ensure that the priest is registered as a solemniser with the state. He should also undertake to contact Fr Kieran well in advance of celebrating your wedding and provide documentary evidence (in compliance with safeguarding regulations) that he is in good standing with his diocesan Bishop or Religious Superior.

Pre-Marriage Course

Because your wedding is a special and important moment in your lives, the Church requires a couple to undertake an approved **Pre-Marriage Course**, details of which your local priest or the solemniser of your wedding will provide.

Pre-Marriage Papers

Both of you will need to fill out the pre-marriage papers (**Pre-Nuptual Enquiry Forms**) with Fr Kieran if you are currently living in St Patrick's Parish. If you are living elsewhere you will fill them out with priest of the parish where you are currently living, and he will then forward them to Fr Kieran along with **Certificates of Baptism, Confirmation and Letters of freedom.** An appointment to meet Fr Kieran or the priest where you live should be made **six months** before the date of the wedding.

In the situation of an Inter-Faith Marriage between a Roman Catholic & Member of another Christian Church or Non-Baptised person it is necessary to get a **dispensation from the Local Bishop**. The Priest dealing with your paperwork will direct you on this matter.

Failure to provide a civil marriage registration form and to satisfactorily complete and submit prenuptial wedding papers before the wedding may result in the wedding being unable to proceed.

For couples living abroad

If you are living abroad you will make an appointment with your local priest (at least six months in advance) who will complete your documentation and forward it to the local Bishops office, who will then forward your papers to the Bishop of Ossory i.e. the Bishop of the Diocese in which St Patrick's Parish is located. Please ensure that all documentation is processed in good time. Weddings cannot be celebrated without the necessary documentation.

The Wedding Ceremony

You will prepare the ceremony with the Priest who will celebrate your wedding. There are two kinds of service in the Catholic Church.

Wedding Service with Nuptial Mass. This is when the wedding itself takes place as part of the Mass. *The other is a Wedding Service without Mass.*

The part where you make your promises is the same in each and both are joyful celebrations. You may find it helpful to discuss the alternatives with your priest before making a final decision.

Your Priest will help you choose the best option for you & assist you in choosing Bible readings etc. and help you decide on the form of the vows you will exchange.

Church Music

You will choose Church hymns or liturgical music that is suitable to the Church, to prayer and to the wedding ceremony and you are asked to talk to your priest when confirming your music choice. Musicians and singers are not permitted to assemble within the sanctuary area of the Church

Wedding Practice

It is the responsibility of the couple to arrange Wedding practices well in advance with the priest celebrating your wedding. To make arrangements for the day of your wedding and to ensure that the Sacristan has been informed etc. please contact Michelle in the Parish Office.

St Patrick's Parish Requirements



Decorating the Church

Each couple will have their own preference when it comes to decorating the Church for your wedding. Flowers are candles are welcome but because of health and safety concerns, natural candles are not permitted outside the Sanctuary area of the Church. A red carpet is permitted. The use of Rice, confetti (even if biodegradable) etc is not permitted inside or outside the Church. No objects including any kind of candles are permitted on the centre aisle especially on the floor. This area is to be kept clear to comply with health and safety regulations.

Photographers/ Video technicians

Photographs provide a wonderful remembrance of your special day. Please inform your Photographers that they should introduce themselves to the Priest before the ceremony begins. Group photographs on the Sanctuary / Altar area are not permitted under any circumstances before or after the wedding ceremony.

This information is gathered to facilitate your wish to get married in the Roman Catholic Church.

The Pre-Nuptial Enquiry Form (PNEF) which you will complete later is normally completed by a priest in your parish of residence. It is his record of his preparation with you and your freedom to marry. The PNEF and supporting documentation (booking forms, baptism certificate, statement of freedom to marry, marriage preparation certificate etc.) are archived in the place of marriage and retained there for 75 years.

The entry in the Marriage Register is a permanent record. To facilitate the issuing of Marriage certificates, the information is also retained on Computerised record System. The information will not be used for any other purpose.
