The Old Pewter Marks of Wigan Pewterers

This article hopes to show **some** of the pewtermarks that have been used by Wigan Pewterers. It will **not** be a comprehensive guide to all known. For that **you need the UK Pewter Society Data base**. Their database is the most detailed ever known, and to use it you need to be a **member** of the UK Pewter Society. 
