INCE-IN-MAKERFIELD is a populous parish ad-
 joining the borough of Wigan, and is in the Ince division of the
 county, hundred of West Derby, Wigan union, petty sessional
 division and county court district, rural deanery of Wigan and
 archdeaconry and diocese of Liverpool. The Lancashire and
 Yorkshire, also the Wigan Junction railways (worked by the
 Great Central railway), at Lower Ince, have stations here, and
 the London and North Western railway and the Leeds and
 Liverpool canal intersect the township. The parish adopted the
 "Local Government Act, 1858," October 23, 1856, but under
 the "Local Government Act, 1894," it is now governed by an
 Urban District Council of 15 members. The ecclesiastical
 parish was formed Nov. 4, 1862, from Wigan. Christ Church,

in Ince Green lane, Higher Ince, was erected in 1863-4, at a
 cost of about £6,000, and is a cruciform building of stone in the
 Early English style, consisting of chancel, nave, aisles,
 western porch, transepts and a small tower on the north side,
 containing one bell; the church has been restored since 1878, at
 a cost of £1,500, and affords sittings for 800 persons. The re-
 gister dates from the year 1894. The living is a vicarage, net
 yearly value about £380, with residence, in the gift of Simeon's
 trustees, and held since 1894 by the Rev. Robert Whitehead M.A.
 of the University of London, and surrogate. The district church
 of St. Mary, LOWER INCE, erected in 1887, at a cost of
 £7,000, by the late Thomas Knowles esq. J.P. and the late John
 Pearson esq. J.P. is a cruciform building in the Early English

style, consisting of chancel, nave, aisles, transepts and a turret with spire, containing one bell: there is a memorial window to the founders, and the church affords 550 sittings. The register dates from the year 1887. The living is a vicarage, net yearly value £310, in the gift of Simeon's trustees, and held since 1887 by the Rev. Thomas Taylor. Here is a Catholic chapel, erected in 1873, and dedicated to St. William, and seats 800. The Primitive Methodist chapel was erected in 1885, at a cost of £800, and seats 350 persons. The Wesleyan chapel, Rose Bridge, built in 1866, seats 300; there is also a chapel for Independents. There are two cemeteries, separated by the London and North Western railway, one belonging to the parish of Wigan, containing 18 acres, and the other to the parish of Ince, consisting of about 6 acres; each has three mortuary chapels, and the latter is governed by a burial board of 5 members. The species of coal called "cannel" is found here, as well as extensive fields of coal of a good quality; the Moss Hall, Springs and Rose Bridge, Gidlow and other collieries are situated here, together with large iron works and forges, railway wagon works and cotton mills. The Walmesley Park, consisting of about 26 acres, was opened in 1895. The principal land-owners are Humphrey Jeffrey Walmesley esq. of Hungerford Park, Berks, who is lord of the manor, Maj. William A. A. J. Ince Anderson, of Euxton, Chorley, John Walmesley esq. of Lucknam, Chippenham, Wilts, and Charles Gidlow Jackson esq. J.P. of Rookwood Hall, Chorley. The soil is clay; subsoil, gravel, sand and coal. The area is 2,220 acres of land and 100 of water; rateable value, £90,416; the population in 1901 was 21,262.

The population of the ecclesiastical parish of Christ Church is 11,440, and of St. Mary, 9,822.

INSKIP with SOWERBY constitute a township 9 miles north-west from Preston, 6 miles north-east from Kirkham, and 4 north from Salwick station on the Preston and Kirkham branch of the Lancashire and Yorkshire railway, and in 1950 were formed into a parish from the civil parish of St. Michael-on-Wyre, in the Lancaster division of the county, petty sessional division of Garstang, hundred of Amounderness, Garstang union and county court district, rural deanery of Garstang, archdeaconry

of Lancaster and diocese of Manchester. The township is supplied with water by the Ryde Water Board. The church of St. Peter, at Inskip, erected in 1943, is a building of stone in the Pointed style, consisting of chancel, nave, north porch and a small turret on the western gable containing one bell; it will seat 800 persons. The register dates from the year 1848. The living is a vicarage, net yearly value £210, with residence, in the gift of the vicar of St. Michael-on-Wyre,
