

An ordinance Approving and Establishing the Lines, Grades, Drainage Structures, and All Other Structures Appearing on the Plans of the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Showing Proposed Improvement on *Railroad and Granville* Streets in the Borough of *Alba* Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, The Department of Highways has submitted to the Borough Council of *Alba* plans showing proposed construction work on State Highway Route No.

*080408* ~~*08041*~~ on *Granville + Railroad* Street, from Station *377+50 to 391+59* and *237+34 to 271+27.89* to Station a distance of *4782.89* feet,

as shown by the plans of said Department of Highways, approved *August 19 1934*.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Borough of *Alba* and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, that the lines, grades, courses, distances, drainage structures, and all other structures shown on the plans prepared and submitted by the Department of Highways as aforesaid, be, and the same are adopted, and are hereby enacted and ordained as and for the true and proper lines, grades, courses, distances, drainage structures, and other structures of and for *Railroad and Granville* Streets, as shown on the said plans.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith the and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its approval as provided by law.
