May 8, 2023

Monthly Meeting

The Alba Borough Council held the regular monthly meeting at 6 pm at the Alba Christian Church. The meeting was opened by President Carol Bastion.

The minutes from the last meeting were read. Lorelei Colton made the motion to approve the minutes, Danielle May seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

Treasurer's report was read. Steve Bastion made a motion to pay the bills and Broc Forbes seconded the motion. The motion passed and the bills will be paid.

Old Business:

The solar streetlight was received, and a brief demonstration of the light was presented by Steve Bastion. Dale Palmer will look into getting a light pole to hang the streetlight on. Terry Lutz has poles being taken out near his property. He said that the borough can have them.

Ron Colton said PennWisp will need to replace a couple poles within the borough, and they may be available for the borough to use as well.

Penelec has finally approved the pole replacements for PennWisp. The next step is for Penelec engineers to replace a couple poled and move some lines.

Carol Bastion Called Doug to discuss some changes at Alba Park. Doug will be meeting with Carol to discuss the possibility of installing a new swing and Carol will inform him to start mowing the entire area at the park. Dale leveled the gravel at the park. Carol is continuing to search for a new signboard and possibly some trash cans. *cluster boxes.*

The dog poop on other neighbors' yards has been resolved at this time.

New Business:

There is a hole along the corner of Windfall and Minnequa Main Road. The state will be informed and if there is no action taken the commissioner will be contacted about the matter.

There have been several complaints regarding a barking dog within the Borough. There was no action taken at this time.

There are many complaints about the abundance of feral cats within the community. There was no action taken at this time.

There was a brief discussion about sheds that have air and electricity in them for the borough to use as a meeting place. The buildings are 12x20 and are about \$13,000. Ron Colton said he would look into what Adam Pepper could do for us in regard to a similar building.

There was a brief discussion on the cluster boxes and getting a foundation and roof. There was no action at this time.

There was a discussion about getting a quote for tar and chip on Cemetery and Sister Street.
