

Alba Borough Minutes

November 8, 2021

Regular Monthly Meeting

The Alba Borough Council held the regular monthly meeting at 6 pm at the Alba Christian Church. The meeting was opened by Vice President Carol Bastion.

The minutes from the last meeting were read. Broc Forbes made the motion to approve the minutes, Lorelei Colton seconded the motion.

Treasurer's report was read. The bill for Bradco Supply will be paid out of the Highway Fund for materials for signs. The invoice for the Do It center will be paid out of the General Fund for materials for the Alba Park's picnic tables. Danielle May made a motion to pay the bills and Steve Bastion seconded the motion. The motion passed and the bills will be paid.

Old Business:

A new 35 MPH Speed Limit Sign was installed along with 7 breakaway poles for the electronic speed sign. The poles were placed near the locations allocated on the map approved by PennDOT. Steve Bastion will look into scheduling an online meeting with the representative for the electronic speed sign for an info session.

The borough garage is on hold until spring. Some trees and trash were removed and cleaned up. There will need to be some window work done eventually. Work on the garage will be a priority project for next summer.

There was no update for the Jake Brake signs.

Equipment has been purchased for the security of the park. There are 2 LED Solar Lights and 2 Wifi Trail Cameras to be installed. There still needs to be security signs and replacement designated smoking signs installed. Steve Bastion and Dale Palmer will look into how to install the trail cameras securely.

The 2022 Budget is ready for review and approval. Carol Bastion will call and place an announcement in the paper. The Budget will be voted on at the next meeting on Monday December 13th, 2021.

New Business:

There was a letter sent from UGI notifying the borough of a red tagged appliance at the property for Box 8.

The Casella contract is due for the next year. Carol Bastion will fill out the survey to be sent in with the contract.

Lorelei Colton brought to the attention of the borough about the Code Red Alert training that will be happening. The paper stated that Cale Holmes, Alba Borough's Emergency Coordinator, will be attending the training on behalf of the borough.
