Available budget	(Money available to spend – specific amount / limited / unlimited)
Allergies	(None / certain foods / types of medicine)
Date of departure	(Usually in mathematical format: 10/02/2029)
Reason for travel	(Types of tourists)
Next of kin	(Someone to be contacted and notified, when the tourist cannot be reached - especially used in emergencies.)
