ORIGINAL UNMARKED WORD ORDER IN A CORNISH SENTENCE

FRONT + PAR + VERB + SUB + COMP / OB + CODA

If gwil, mydnas, gallos or godhvos is used as auxiliary verb, the unmarked word order becomes:

FRONT + PAR + VERB + SUB + VN + OB + CODA

If **bos** is used periphrastically, the unmarked word order is:

FRONT + PAR + VERB + SUB + PRES-PA + OB + CODA

CODA	ADVERBIAL CODA
COMP	COMPLEMENT
FRONT	FRONTING SLOT – SUB, COMP / OB or elements of CODA may be moved into it No fronting allowed in interrogatives or sub-clauses
OB	OBJECT – indirect object noun usually follows direct object, indirect object pronoun usually precedes direct object
PAR	PARTICLE (with mutation), in some circumstances omitted (but mutation remains)
PRES-PA	so called PRESENT PARTICIPLE
SUB	SUBJECT
VERB	INFLECTED VERB
VN	VERB-NOUN

The unmarked word order in CODA is:

PLACE + MANNER + TIME

but clauses are postponed to the end
