Since 2012, the WGA18 has been a leading participant in the Crush Cancer Golf Sale. Today, more than 11 golf groups donate and work towards the success of this event. Since 2012, the Crush Cancer Umbrella, golf tournaments and sales, has raised over \$236,718.

This year, the Crush Cancer Golf Sale will take place on April 19th from 4:00 PM to 5:30 PM for members only. Open to the public on April 20th from 10:00 AM to 4:30 PM, and on April 21st from 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM at the Community of Joy Church located at 110 Balboa Rd. The church has generously donated the space, ensuring that 100% of the funds raised will go to cancer research.

We are asking for your donations of gently used clothing and smaller items at our Spring General Meeting on April 13th. Please bring your clothing, shoes, and other gently used soft items to the check-in table. For larger donations, please contact Nancy Pfeiffer at 214-448-8559.
