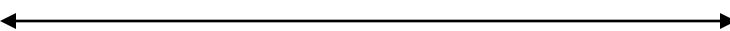
## STARTERS:

Also, when you play be sure to stop by the starter table to get checked in, get your score card and find out any special info for the game of the day – AND enter for closest to the pin!!



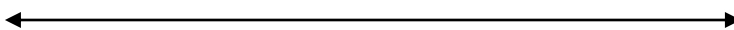
## HOLE-IN-ONE:
