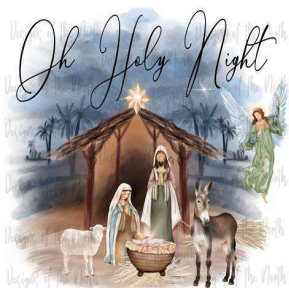
First Holy Communion Preparation
